## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1267

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 25b (MCL 257.25b), as added by 2000 PA 82.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 25b. "Low-speed vehicle" means <u>an electrically powered</u>

  vehicle designed to be operated at a speed not to exceed 35 miles

  per hour with a capacity of not more than 4 persons including the

  driver of 2,200 pounds or less in weight as described in 49 C.F.R.

  571.500 that is equipped with, but not limited to, the following:

  (a) Headlamps.
- 7 (b) Front and rear turn signal lamps, tail lamps, and stop
- 8 <del>lamps.</del>

- 1 (c) Reflex reflectors: 1 red on each side as far to the rear
- 2 as practicable, and 1 red on the rear.
- 3 (d) An exterior mirror mounted on the driver's side of the
- 4 vehicle and either an exterior mirror mounted on the passenger's
- 5 side of the vehicle or an interior mirror.
- 6 (e) A parking brake.
- 7 (f) A windshield that meets the standards prescribed by this
- 8 act.
- 9 (g) A vehicle identification number.
- 10 (h) A seat belt assembly conforming to the requirements of
- 11 this act installed at each designated seating position. A SELF-
- 12 PROPELLED MOTOR VEHICLE TO WHICH BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 13 (A) THE VEHICLE CONFORMS TO THE DEFINITION OF LOW-SPEED
- 14 VEHICLE UNDER 49 CFR 571.3(B).
- 15 (B) THE VEHICLE MEETS THE STANDARD FOR LOW-SPEED VEHICLES
- 16 UNDER 49 CFR 571.500.
