## SENATE BILL NO. 1364

A bill to amend 1964 PA 154, entitled "Minimum wage law of 1964,"

by amending section 4b (MCL 408.384b), as added by 1997 PA 1.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4b. (1) An employer may pay a new employee who is less
- 2 than 20 years of age a training hourly wage of \$4.25 for the first
- 3 90 days of that employee's employment. The hourly wage authorized
- 4 under this -section SUBSECTION is in lieu of the minimum hourly
- 5 wage otherwise prescribed by this act.
- 6 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1), THE MINIMUM HOURLY
- 7 WAGE FOR AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE IS 85% OF THE
- 8 GENERAL MINIMUM HOURLY WAGE ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 4.
- 9 (3) -(2) An employer shall not displace an employee to hire

- 1 an individual at the hourly wage authorized under -subsection (1)
- 2 THIS SECTION. As used in this subsection, "displace" includes
- 3 termination of employment or any reduction of hours, wages, or

- 6 subject to a civil fine of not more than \$1,000.00.
