ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5309

AN ACT to amend 1976 PA 228, entitled "An act to provide for scholarships to high school graduates of this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the Michigan higher education assistance authority," by amending section 4 (MCL 390.1304), as amended by 2004 PA 182.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:


Sec. 4. A person is eligible for a scholarship award if the person meets all of the following qualifications:

- (a) Has resided in this state continuously for the preceding 12 months and is not considered a resident of any other state.
- (b) Is a United States citizen or any other student described as eligible to receive title IV, HEA program assistance under 34 CFR 668.33.
- (c) Has not graduated from high school at the time of the scholarship examination.
- (d) Enrolls in a recognized postsecondary educational institution within 4 years after graduation from high school.
- (e) Is not enrolled in an institution whose primary purpose is to prepare students for ordination or appointment as a member of the clergy of a church, denomination, or religious association, order, or sect.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are enacted into law:

- (a) House Bill No. 5300.
- (b) House Bill No. 5301.
- (c) House Bill No. 5302.
- (d) House Bill No. 5303.
- (e) House Bill No. 5304.
- (f) House Bill No. 5305.
- (g) House Bill No. 5306.
- (h) House Bill No. 5307.
- (i) House Bill No. 5308.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
