

# HOUSE BILL No. 4005

January 27, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Caswell and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled  
"The revised school code,"  
by amending section 626 (MCL 380.626).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 626. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), **NOT LATER**  
2 **THAN JULY 1 OF EACH ODD-NUMBERED YEAR,** the intermediate school  
3 board shall prepare **AND FILE** a map of the intermediate school  
4 district as of **THAT** July 1, ~~1977, and biennially on July 1~~  
5 ~~thereafter,~~ showing by district lines the boundaries of each  
6 constituent district. In the period intervening between publication  
7 dates, the intermediate school board shall report each boundary  
8 change to the principal officers of the affected municipalities and  
9 townships, the state board, and the secretary of state. One copy of

1 the map shall be filed ~~biennially, beginning July 1, 1977, or as~~  
2 ~~soon as possible thereafter,~~ with each of the clerks of the  
3 respective townships and cities, 1 copy with the secretary of each  
4 constituent district, 1 copy with the state board, and 1 copy with  
5 the secretary of state.

6 (2) An intermediate school board ~~shall not be~~ **IS NOT**  
7 required to prepare or file a new map of the intermediate school  
8 district if the boundaries of its constituent districts have not  
9 changed subsequent to the last filing.

10 (3) **IF THERE IS A DISPUTE CONCERNING THE BOUNDARIES OF ITS**  
11 **CONSTITUENT DISTRICTS FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED**  
12 **TO, A DISPUTE CONCERNING THE CONSTITUENT DISTRICT IN WHICH A**  
13 **PARTICULAR PARCEL OF TAXABLE PROPERTY IS LOCATED, THE INTERMEDIATE**  
14 **SCHOOL BOARD, AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE ASSESSOR OF THE LOCAL TAX**  
15 **COLLECTING UNIT, SHALL DECIDE THE DISPUTE. IF THERE IS A DISPUTE**  
16 **CONCERNING THE BOUNDARIES OF 2 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS FOR**  
17 **ANY REASON, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A DISPUTE CONCERNING THE**  
18 **INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT IN WHICH A PARTICULAR PARCEL OF**  
19 **TAXABLE PROPERTY IS LOCATED, THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL BOARDS OF THE**  
20 **AFFECTED INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS MEETING JOINTLY, AFTER**  
21 **CONSULTING WITH THE ASSESSOR OF THE LOCAL TAX COLLECTING UNIT,**  
22 **SHALL DECIDE THE DISPUTE BY A MAJORITY VOTE. THE DECISION OF THE**  
23 **INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL BOARD OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL BOARDS MEETING**  
24 **JOINTLY, AS APPLICABLE, IS FINAL. HOWEVER, A BOUNDARY CHANGE UNDER**  
25 **SECTION 701, 702, OR 703 OR PART 9, 10, 10A, OR 11 IS GOVERNED BY**  
26 **THE APPLICABLE SECTION OR PART.**
