HOUSE BILL No. 4023

January 27, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Stewart and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Great Lakes, Land Use and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding part 312.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 PART 312 WATERSHED ALLIANCES

2 SEC. 31201. AS USED IN THIS PART:

- 3 (A) "COUNTY AGENCY" MEANS AN AGENCY CREATED OR CONTROLLED BY A
- 4 COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OR A COUNTY EXECUTIVE, A BOARD OF
- 5 COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS, OR AN OFFICE OF THE COUNTY DRAIN
- 6 COMMISSIONER.
- 7 (B) "MEMBER" MEANS A MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY, COUNTY AGENCY,
- 8 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT, PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, OR OTHER
 - LOCAL OR REGIONAL PUBLIC AGENCY THAT IS A MEMBER OF A WATERSHED

- 1 ALLIANCE.
- 2 (C) "WATERSHED" MEANS A GEOGRAPHIC AREA IN THE STATE WITHIN
- 3 WHICH SURFACE WATER DRAINS INTO A COMMON RIVER, STREAM, OR BODY OF
- 4 WATER.
- 5 (D) "WATERSHED ALLIANCE" MEANS AN ORGANIZATION ESTABLISHED
- 6 UNDER SECTION 31202.
- 7 (E) "WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PLAN" MEANS A WRITTEN DOCUMENT
- 8 PREPARED AND APPROVED BY A WATERSHED ALLIANCE THAT IDENTIFIES WATER
- 9 MANAGEMENT ISSUES AND PROBLEMS, PROPOSES GOALS AND OBJECTIVES, AND
- 10 OUTLINES ACTIONS TO ACHIEVE THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES IDENTIFIED BY
- 11 MEMBERS OF A WATERSHED ALLIANCE.
- 12 SEC. 31202. (1) TWO OR MORE MUNICIPALITIES, BY RESOLUTION OF
- 13 THEIR RESPECTIVE GOVERNING BODIES, MAY ESTABLISH A WATERSHED
- 14 ALLIANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF STUDYING PROBLEMS AND PLANNING AND
- 15 IMPLEMENTING ACTIVITIES DESIGNED TO ADDRESS SURFACE WATER QUALITY
- 16 OR WATER FLOW ISSUES OF MUTUAL CONCERN IN A WATERSHED, INCLUDING 1
- 17 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (A) PREPARATION OF WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PLANS AND OTHER
- 19 REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AS PART OF STATE OR FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS TO
- 20 OBTAIN WATER DISCHARGE PERMITS OR GRANT FUNDING.
- 21 (B) MONITORING, SAMPLING, AND ANALYSES OF DATA NECESSARY TO
- 22 MANAGE THE WATERSHED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SURFACE WATER
- 23 QUALITY, WATER QUANTITY AND FLOWS, ECOSYSTEM HEALTH, RECREATIONAL
- 24 USE, AND THE PUBLICATION OF RESULTS.
- 25 (C) CONDUCTING PUBLIC SURVEYS, PREPARING AND DISTRIBUTING
- 26 INFORMATIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS, AND ORGANIZING ACTIVITIES
- 27 INVOLVING THE PUBLIC.

- 1 (D) DESIGNING AND IMPLEMENTING PROJECTS AND CONDUCTING
- 2 ACTIVITIES TO PROTECT OR ENHANCE WATER QUALITY AND RELATED
- 3 BENEFICIAL USES, OR MANAGE FLOWS TO PROTECT OR REDUCE DAMAGE TO
- 4 RIPARIAN PROPERTY AND AQUATIC HABITAT.
- 5 (E) DESIGNING AND IMPLEMENTING OTHER ACTIONS CONSISTENT WITH
- 6 WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PLANS ADOPTED BY A WATERSHED ALLIANCE, OR
- 7 REQUIRED TO PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH, AND MAINTAIN AND RESTORE
- 8 BENEFICIAL PUBLIC USES OF THE SURFACE WATER RESOURCES OF THE
- 9 WATERSHED.
- 10 (2) A RESOLUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (1) ESTABLISHING A WATERSHED
- 11 ALLIANCE SHALL INCLUDE BYLAWS THAT IDENTIFY, AT A MINIMUM, ALL OF
- 12 THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (A) THE STRUCTURE OF THE ORGANIZATION AND DECISION-MAKING
- 14 PROCESS.
- 15 (B) THE GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES OF THE WATERSHED.
- 16 (C) THE MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES, COUNTY AGENCIES, PUBLIC
- 17 SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND OTHER LOCAL OR REGIONAL PUBLIC AGENCIES
- 18 ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE WATERSHED ALLIANCE AS PROVIDED UNDER
- 19 SUBSECTION (3).
- 20 (D) THE BASIS FOR ASSESSING COSTS TO MEMBERS.
- 21 (E) A MECHANISM TO BE USED FOR ADOPTION OF AN ANNUAL BUDGET TO
- 22 SUPPORT PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES.
- 23 (3) A WATERSHED ALLIANCE SHALL PROVIDE AN EQUITABLE BASIS FOR
- 24 ALL MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES, AND COUNTY AGENCIES WITHIN THE
- 25 GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES OF THE WATERSHED TO VOLUNTARILY JOIN AS
- 26 MEMBERS. IN ADDITION, AT ITS DISCRETION, THE WATERSHED ALLIANCE MAY
- 27 AUTHORIZE THE VOLUNTARY MEMBERSHIP OF ANY LOCAL PUBLIC SCHOOL

- 1 DISTRICT, PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, OR ANY OTHER LOCAL OR
- 2 REGIONAL PUBLIC AGENCY THAT HAS WATER MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES.
- 3 FOLLOWING ESTABLISHMENT OF A WATERSHED ALLIANCE UNDER SUBSECTION
- 4 (1), BY RESOLUTION OF ITS GOVERNING BODY, A MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY,
- 5 COUNTY AGENCY, PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT, PUBLIC COLLEGE OR
- 6 UNIVERSITY, OR OTHER LOCAL OR REGIONAL PUBLIC AGENCY ESTABLISHED
- 7 UNDER STATE LAW WITH SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITY MAY
- 8 VOLUNTARILY JOIN A WATERSHED ALLIANCE AS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS
- 9 SUBSECTION.
- 10 SEC. 31203. A WATERSHED ALLIANCE IS A BODY CORPORATE WITH
- 11 POWER TO SUE AND BE SUED IN ANY COURT OF THIS STATE AND WITH THE
- 12 AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT ITS RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS PART AND AS
- 13 OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.
- 14 SEC. 31204. (1) A WATERSHED ALLIANCE, CONSISTENT WITH THE
- 15 PURPOSES IDENTIFIED IN SECTION 31202 AND ITS BYLAWS, MAY DO 1 OR
- 16 MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 17 (A) EMPLOY PERSONNEL TO COORDINATE AND IMPLEMENT ACTIONS.
- 18 (B) ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS OR CONTRACTS WITH PUBLIC OR PRIVATE
- 19 ENTITIES TO COORDINATE OR IMPLEMENT ACTIONS.
- 20 (C) ASSESS AND COLLECT FEES FROM MEMBERS WITH APPROVAL OF THE
- 21 GOVERNING BODIES OF THE MEMBERS.
- 22 (D) SOLICIT GRANTS, GIFTS, AND CONTRIBUTIONS FROM FEDERAL,
- 23 STATE, REGIONAL, OR LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCIES AND FROM PRIVATE SOURCES.
- 24 (E) EXPEND FUNDS PROVIDED BY MEMBERS, OR THROUGH GRANTS,
- 25 GIFTS, AND CONTRIBUTIONS.
- 26 (F) REPRESENT MEMBERS OF THE WATERSHED ALLIANCE BEFORE OTHER
- 27 BODIES CONSIDERING ISSUES AFFECTING WATER QUALITY OR FLOW

- 1 MANAGEMENT ISSUES WITHIN THE DESIGNATED WATERSHED, INCLUDING
- 2 OBTAINING LOCAL, STATE, OR FEDERAL PERMITS OR AUTHORIZATIONS THAT
- 3 MAY BE REQUIRED TO CARRY OUT ACTIVITIES AS MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY ITS
- 4 MEMBERS.
- 5 (2) A WATERSHED ALLIANCE SHALL PREPARE AND DELIVER TO ITS
- 6 MEMBERS ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1 OF EACH YEAR A REPORT DETAILING THE
- 7 REVENUE RECEIVED AND EXPENDITURES BY THE WATERSHED ALLIANCE DURING
- 8 THE IMMEDIATELY PRIOR JANUARY 1 THROUGH DECEMBER 31 PERIOD.
- 9 (3) A WATERSHED ALLIANCE DOES NOT HAVE INDEPENDENT AUTHORITY
- 10 TO ASSESS OR COLLECT ANY FEES OR TAXES DIRECTLY FROM INDIVIDUALS OR
- 11 PROPERTY OWNERS. A WATERSHED ALLIANCE MEMBER MAY ALLOCATE THE USE
- 12 OF PUBLIC FUNDS FROM FEES, TAXES, OR ASSESSMENTS GENERATED UNDER
- 13 THE PROVISIONS OF OTHER STATE LAWS FOR USE BY A WATERSHED ALLIANCE.
- 14 SEC. 31205. (1) A WATERSHED ALLIANCE SHALL OBTAIN AN AUDIT OF
- 15 ITS FINANCIAL RECORDS, ACCOUNTS, AND PROCEDURES AT LEAST EVERY
- 16 OTHER YEAR.
- 17 (2) A WATERSHED ALLIANCE SHALL SUBMIT THE RESULTS OF AN AUDIT
- 18 UNDER SUBSECTION (1) TO THE GOVERNING BODIES OF ITS MEMBERS AND TO
- 19 THE STATE TREASURER.
- 20 (3) AN AUDIT UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL SATISFY ALL AUDIT
- 21 REQUIREMENTS SET UNDER THE UNIFORM BUDGETING AND ACCOUNTING ACT,
- 22 1968 PA 2, MCL 141.421 TO 141.440A.
