

HOUSE BILL No. 4045

January 27, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Lemmons, Jr. and Lemmons, III and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 411u.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 411U. (1) IF A CREDIT CARD OR DEBIT CARD IS USED FOR
2 PAYMENT IN A CONSUMER TRANSACTION, A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE CONDUCT
3 OF TRADE OR COMMERCE SHALL NOT ISSUE OR DELIVER A RECEIPT TO THE
4 CONSUMER THAT DISPLAYS ANY PART OF THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE CARD
5 OR MORE THAN THE LAST 4 DIGITS OF THE CONSUMER'S ACCOUNT NUMBER.

6 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
7 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00.

8 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "TRADE OR COMMERCE" MEANS THAT

1 TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE MICHIGAN CONSUMER PROTECTION
2 ACT, 1976 PA 331, MCL 445.902.
