

HOUSE BILL No. 4118

February 1, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Acciavatti, Sheltroun, Palmer, Robertson, Pavlov,
Gosselin, LaJoy, Nitz, Gaffney and Walker and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1318.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1318. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT ITS POLICIES
3 CONCERNING A PUPIL'S ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN
4 INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS INCLUDE USE OF A PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING
5 SUBSTANCE BY THE PUPIL AS A VIOLATION THAT WILL AFFECT A PUPIL'S
6 ELIGIBILITY, AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

7 (2) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT OF
8 COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL DEVELOP, PERIODICALLY UPDATE, AND MAKE

1 AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS, PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES, AND
2 NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS A LIST OF PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING SUBSTANCES. THE
3 DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL BASE THE LIST ON THE LIST OF
4 BANNED DRUGS CONTAINED IN BYLAW 31.2.3.1 OF THE BYLAWS OF THE
5 NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION.
