A bill to amend 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1, entitled "Michigan employment security act,"

by amending the title and section 5b (MCL 421.5b), the title as amended by 1991 PA 10 and section 5b as added by 2002 PA 192.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to protect the welfare of the people of this state
through the establishment of an unemployment compensation fund, and
to provide for the disbursement thereof; to create certain other
funds; to create the <u>Michigan employment security commission</u>

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE AGENCY, and to prescribe its powers and
duties; to provide for the protection of the people of this state
from the hazards of unemployment; to levy and provide for

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- 1 contributions from employers; to provide for the collection of such
- 2 contributions; to enter into reciprocal agreements and to cooperate
- 3 with agencies of the United States and of other states charged with
- 4 the administration of any unemployment insurance law; to furnish
- 5 certain information to certain governmental agencies for use in
- 6 administering public benefit and child support programs and
- 7 investigating and prosecuting fraud; to provide for the payment of
- 8 benefits; to provide for appeals from redeterminations, decisions,
- 9 and notices of assessments; —and— TO PROVIDE for referees and a
- 10 board of review to hear and decide the issues arising from
- 11 redeterminations, decisions, and notices of assessment; to provide
- 12 for the cooperation of this state and compliance with the

- 15 for the establishment and maintenance of free public employment
- 16 offices; to provide for the transfer of funds; to make
- 17 appropriations for carrying out the provisions of this act; to
- 18 prescribe remedies and penalties for the violation of the
- 19 provisions of this act; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts
- 20 inconsistent with the provisions of this act.

- 22 compensation— UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE AGENCY is created within the
- 23 department of -consumer and industry services LABOR AND ECONOMIC

- 25 (2) The <u>bureau</u> **AGENCY** shall be headed by a director. —who
- 26 shall be appointed by the governor.
- 27 (3) All of the authority, powers, functions, duties, and

- 2 are transferred to the -bureau UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE AGENCY as

- 5 of the director of the unemployment agency, defined as the director
- 6 of employment security in Executive Order No. 1997-12, provided

- 8 INSURANCE AGENCY as provided in Executive Order No. $\frac{2002-1}{2003}$
