

HOUSE BILL No. 4227

February 8, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Ward and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Policy.

A bill to amend 1966 PA 261, entitled

"An act to provide for the apportionment of county boards of commissioners; to prescribe the size of the board; to provide for appeals; to prescribe the manner of election of the members of the county board of commissioners; to provide for compensation of members; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 15 (MCL 46.415), as amended by 1980 PA 187.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 15. (1) A member of the county board of commissioners
2 shall receive the compensation and mileage reimbursement fixed by
3 resolution of the county board of commissioners or for a county
4 which has a county officers compensation commission, fixed by a
5 determination of the county officers compensation commission which
6 is not rejected.

7 (2) The per mile mileage reimbursement fixed by the county

1 board of commissioners or the county officers compensation
2 commission shall not exceed the mileage reimbursement set for state
3 officers as determined by the state officers compensation
4 commission. ~~Changes~~

5 **(3) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (5), CHANGES** in
6 compensation shall become effective only ~~at~~ **AFTER** the time
7 members of the county board of commissioners commence their terms
8 of office after a general election, or for a county which has a
9 county officers compensation commission, ~~at~~ **AFTER** the beginning
10 of the first odd numbered year after the determination is made by
11 the county officers compensation commission and is not rejected.

12 **(4) THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT A**
13 **STRUCTURED CHANGE IN COMPENSATION IMPLEMENTED IN PHASES OVER THE**
14 **TERM OF OFFICE.**

15 **(5) A CHANGE IN COMPENSATION UNDER SUBSECTION (1) MAY BE MADE**
16 **IN 2005 TO BE EFFECTIVE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2006.**

17 **(6)** As used in this section, "compensation" shall not include
18 mileage reimbursement.
