## **HOUSE BILL No. 4305**

February 15, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Hummel and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled
"The state school aid act of 1979,"
by amending section 11 (MCL 388.1611), as amended by 2004 PA 518.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1	Sec. II. (1) <del>in addition to all other appropriations under</del>
2	this act for that fiscal year, for the fiscal year ending September
3	30, 2004, there is appropriated to the state school aid fund from
4	the unreserved balance in the general fund an amount equal to any
5	deficit balance that would otherwise exist in the state school aid
6	fund at bookclosing for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004.
7	For the fiscal year ending September 30, $\frac{2005}{2006}$ , there is
8	appropriated for the public schools of this state and certain other
9	state purposes relating to education the sum of $\$10,909,200,000.00$
0	\$00 from the state school aid fund established by
1	section 11 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963 and the

- 1 sum of \$264,700,000.00 \$\_\_\_\_\_.00 from the general fund. In
- 2 addition, available federal funds are appropriated for each of
- 3 those fiscal years.
- 4 (2) The appropriations under this section shall be allocated
- 5 as provided in this act. Money appropriated under this section from
- 6 the general fund shall be expended to fund the purposes of this act
- 7 before the expenditure of money appropriated under this section
- 8 from the state school aid fund. If the maximum amount appropriated
- 9 under this section from the state school aid fund for a fiscal year
- 10 exceeds the amount necessary to fully fund allocations under this
- 11 act from the state school aid fund, that excess amount shall not be
- 12 expended in that state fiscal year and shall not lapse to the
- 13 general fund, but instead shall be deposited into the school aid
- 14 stabilization fund created in section 11a.
- 15 (3) If the maximum amount appropriated under this section from
- 16 the state school aid fund and the school aid stabilization fund for
- 17 a fiscal year exceeds the amount available for expenditure from the
- 18 state school aid fund for that fiscal year, payments under sections
- 19 11f, 11g, 11j, 22a, 26a, 31d, 51a(2), 51a(12), 51c, 53a, and 56
- 20 shall be made in full. In addition, for districts beginning
- 21 operations after 1994-95 that qualify for payments under section
- 22 22b, payments under section 22b shall be made so that the
- 23 qualifying districts receive the lesser of an amount equal to the
- 24 1994-95 foundation allowance of the district in which the district
- 25 beginning operations after 1994-95 is located or \$5,500.00. The
- 26 amount of the payment to be made under section 22b for these
- 27 qualifying districts shall be as calculated under section 22a, with

- 2 proration otherwise provided under this subsection and subsection
- **3** (4). Subject to subsection (5), if proration is necessary after
- 4 2002-2003, state payments under each of the other sections of this
- 5 act from all state funding sources shall be prorated in the manner
- 6 prescribed in subsection (4) as necessary to reflect the amount
- 7 available for expenditure from the state school aid fund for the
- 8 affected fiscal year. However, if the department of treasury
- 9 determines that proration will be required under this subsection,
- 10 or if the department of treasury determines that further proration
- 11 is required under this subsection after an initial proration has
- 12 already been made for a fiscal year, the department of treasury
- 13 shall notify the state budget director, and the state budget

- 18 period after that notification by the state budget director, the
- 19 department shall not reduce any payments under this act because of
- 20 proration under this subsection. The legislature may prevent
- 21 proration from occurring by, within the 30 calendar day or 6
- 22 legislative session day period after that notification by the state
- 23 budget director, enacting legislation appropriating additional
- 24 funds from the general fund, countercyclical budget and economic
- 25 stabilization fund, state school aid fund balance, or another
- 26 source to fund the amount of the projected shortfall.
- 27 (4) Subject to subsection (5), if proration is necessary, the

- 1 department shall calculate the proration in district and
- 2 intermediate district payments that is required under subsection
- 3 (3) as follows:
- 4 (a) The department shall calculate the percentage of total
- 5 state school aid allocated under this act for the affected fiscal
- 6 year for each of the following:
- 7 (i) Districts.
- 8 (ii) Intermediate districts.
- 9 (iii) Entities other than districts or intermediate districts.
- 10 (b) The department shall recover a percentage of the proration
- 11 amount required under subsection (3) that is equal to the
- 12 percentage calculated under subdivision (a)(i) for districts by
- 13 reducing payments to districts. This reduction shall be made by
- 14 calculating an equal dollar amount per pupil as necessary to
- 15 recover this percentage of the proration amount and reducing each
- 16 district's total state school aid from state sources, other than
- 17 payments under sections 11f, 11g, 11j, 22a, 26a, 31d, 51a(2),
- 18 51a(12), 51c, and 53a, by that amount.
- 19 (c) The department shall recover a percentage of the proration
- 20 amount required under subsection (3) that is equal to the
- 21 percentage calculated under subdivision (a)(ii) for intermediate
- 22 districts by reducing payments to intermediate districts. This
- 23 reduction shall be made by reducing the payments to each
- 24 intermediate district, other than payments under sections 11f, 11g,
- 25 26a, 51a(2), 51a(12), 53a, and 56, on an equal percentage basis.
- 26 (d) The department shall recover a percentage of the proration
- 27 amount required under subsection (3) that is equal to the

- 1 percentage calculated under subdivision (a)(iii) for entities other
- 2 than districts and intermediate districts by reducing payments to
- 3 these entities. This reduction shall be made by reducing the
- 4 payments to each of these entities, other than payments under
- 5 sections 11j and 26a, on an equal percentage basis.
- 6 (5) Beginning in 2004-2005, if a district has an emergency
- 7 financial manager in place under the local government fiscal
- 8 responsibility act, 1990 PA 72, MCL 141.1201 to 141.1291, payments
- 9 to that district are not subject to proration under this section.
- 10 (6) Except for the allocation under section 26a, any general
- 11 fund allocations under this act that are not expended by the end of
- 12 the state fiscal year are transferred to the state school aid fund.
- 13 If it is determined at the May 2005 revenue estimating conference
- 14 conducted under section 367b of the management and budget act, 1984
- 15 PA 431, MCL 18.1367b, that there is additional school aid fund
- 16 revenue beyond that determined at the May 2004 revenue estimating
- 17 conference, then it is the intent of the legislature to enact
- 18 legislation to fund, to the extent that revenues are available, the
- 19 same programs in the same amount that were funded under section 81
- 20 in 2003 PA 236 and the same pupil membership formula as in effect
- 21 under 2003 PA 236.
