WHEN A JUVENILE IS DETERMINED TO BE WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COURT UNDER SECTION 2(A)(4) DUE TO WILLFUL AND REPEATED ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL OR ANOTHER LEARNING PROGRAM, THE COURT SHALL IMMEDIATELY AFTER ENTRY OF A COURT ORDER OF DISPOSITION FOR THE JUVENILE, PREPARE AND FORWARD AN ABSTRACT OF THE RECORD OF THE COURT FOR THE CASE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE. UPON RECEIPT OF THE ABSTRACT OF THE RECORD, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SUSPEND THE
