March 1, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Espinoza, Sak, Wojno, Condino, Bieda, Gleason, Kehrl, Tobocman, Alma Smith and Plakas and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 676a (MCL 257.676a), as amended by 1999 PA 46.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 676a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person, firm, or corporation who sells or offers for sale, or displays or attempts to display for sale, goods, wares, produce, fruit, vegetables, or merchandise within the right-of-way of a highway outside of the corporate limits of a city or village —, or within the right-of-way of a state trunk line highway, is responsible for a civil infraction.
 - (2) This section does not interfere with a permanently established business that, as of September 27, 1957, was located on or partially on private property or grant to the owner of that

- 1 business additional rights or authority that the owner did not
- 2 possess on September 27, 1957, or diminish the legal rights or
- 3 duties of the authority having jurisdiction of the right-of-way.
- 4 (3) In conjunction with the exemption granted by federal law
- 5 from the restrictions contained in section 111 of title 23 of the
- 6 United States Code, 23 U.S.C. USC 111, and described in the "manual
- 7 on uniform traffic control devices for streets and highways", U.S.
- 8 department of transportation and federal highway administration,
- 9 part 2g (LOGOS), this section does not prohibit the use of a
- 10 facility located in part on the right-of-way of I-94 in the
- 11 vicinity of the interchange of I-94 and I-69 business loop/I-94
- 12 business loop for the sale of only those articles which are for
- 13 export and consumption outside the United States.
- 14 (4) This section does not prohibit the use of logo signage
- 15 within the right-of-way of limited access highways. For purposes of
- 16 this subsection, "logo signage" means a sign containing the
- 17 trademark or other symbol that identifies a business in a manner
- 18 and at locations approved by the state transportation department.
- 19 The state transportation department may enter into agreements to
- 20 allow logo signage, and any revenue received by the state
- 21 transportation department under this subsection shall be deposited
- 22 into the state trunk line fund established under section 11 of 1951
