HOUSE BILL No. 4533

March 22, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Vander Veen, Taub, Gosselin, Nofs, Robertson, Jones, Kahn, Stewart, Stahl, Huizenga and Shaffer and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2001 PA 124, and by adding section 811m; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 811e. (1) The secretary of state may develop a Michigan university fund-raising registration plate as described in this section, and a matching Michigan university collector plate as described in section 811g.
 - (2) The secretary of state may develop 1 or more limited term registration plates to recognize a state-sponsored event, a Michigan university, or an accomplishment or occasion of a Michigan university.

- 1 (3) The secretary of state may -, at any 1 time, develop not
- 2 more than 7 different DEVELOP state-sponsored fund-raising
- 3 registration plates as described in this section, and matching
- 4 state-sponsored collector plates as described in section 811g. As
- 5 used in this section, "state-sponsored fund-raising registration
- 6 plate" means a fund-raising registration plate authorized by a
- 7 public act to raise funds for a state-sponsored goal. The public
- 8 act shall, at a minimum, do all of the following:
- 9 (a) Identify the purpose of the state-sponsored fund-raising
- 10 registration plate.
- 11 (b) Create a fund or designate an existing fund to receive the
- 12 money raised through the sale of state-sponsored fund-raising
- 13 registration plates and matching collector plates.
- 14 (c) If a fund is created, name the person or entity
- 15 responsible for administering the fund.
- 16 (4) The secretary of state may develop, promote, and market
- 17 the fund-raising registration plates and matching collector plates
- 18 issued under this section with the funds available through service
- 19 fees.
- 20 (5) If the design or logo of a Michigan university fund-
- 21 raising registration plate or a state-sponsored fund-raising
- 22 registration plate uses 1 or more designs, trade names, trademarks,
- 23 service marks, emblems, symbols, or other images that are owned by
- 24 the Michigan university that is requesting the Michigan university
- 25 fund-raising plate, the person or entity that is sponsoring a
- 26 state-sponsored fund-raising plate, or any other person or entity,
- 27 the Michigan university or sponsoring person or entity shall grant

- 1 to or obtain for the secretary of state both of the following
- 2 pursuant to a written agreement between the parties:
- 3 (a) A nonexclusive worldwide license to use those designs,
- 4 trade names, trademarks, service marks, emblems, symbols, or other
- 5 images on and in conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale,
- 6 or copyrighting of the registration plate or image of the
- 7 registration plate.
- 8 (b) The authority to merchandise the registration plate or an
- 9 image of the registration plate.
- 10 (6) In using or employing a design, trade name, trademark,
- 11 service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image on and in
- 12 conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or
- 13 merchandising of a registration plate or image of the registration
- 14 plate, the secretary of state may alter the size of the design,
- 15 trade name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other
- 16 image but shall not change the color or design of the design, trade
- 17 name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image
- 18 without the prior written consent of the respective Michigan
- 19 university or sponsoring person or entity. The secretary of state
- 20 shall not use or employ a design, trade name, trademark, service
- 21 mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image on and in conjunction
- 22 with the marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or merchandising
- 23 of a registration plate or an image of the registration plate in
- 24 any manner that is offensive to the Michigan university or
- 25 sponsoring person or entity that complies with subsection (5).
- 26 (7) As used in this section, "Michigan university fund-raising
- 27 registration plate" means a fund-raising registration plate that is

- 1 issued under this section at the request of a Michigan university.
- 2 SEC. 811M. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
- 3 SECTION 811E AND MAY ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A STATE-SPONSORED
- 4 FUND-RAISING REGISTRATION PLATE HONORING MICHIGAN NURSES AND A
- 5 MATCHING MICHIGAN NURSES COLLECTOR PLATE AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION
- 6 811G. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DESIGN THE PLATES IN COOPERATION
- 7 WITH THE MICHIGAN NURSES. FUND-RAISING DONATIONS FOR PLATES
- 8 DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION THAT ARE COLLECTED UNDER SECTIONS 811F
- 9 AND 811G SHALL BE TRANSFERRED UNDER SECTION 811H BY THE SECRETARY
- 10 OF STATE TO THE STATE TREASURER TO BE CREDITED TO THE MICHIGAN
- 11 NURSES FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (2).
- 12 (2) THE MICHIGAN NURSES FUND IS CREATED IN THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 13 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
- 14 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
- 15 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND AND SHALL CREDIT TO THE
- 16 FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS. MONEY IN THE FUND
- 17 AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL
- 18 NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE
- 19 MONEY IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 811H TO THE MICHIGAN
- 20 NURSES FOUNDATION, WHICH SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY FOR THE FOLLOWING
- 21 PURPOSES:
- 22 (A) TO RETAIN LICENSED NURSES IN THE WORKFORCE OF THIS STATE
- 23 BY PROVIDING FINANCIAL AID FOR NURSING PROFESSIONALS RECOVERING
- 24 FROM SUBSTANCE ABUSE WHO REQUIRE MEDICAL HEALTH TREATMENT, OR
- 25 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TREATMENT, OR BOTH, THROUGH A QUALIFIED TREATMENT
- 26 PROGRAM.
- 27 (B) TO RECRUIT AND ADVANCE THE NEXT GENERATION OF LICENSED

- 1 NURSES IN THE WORKFORCE OF THIS STATE BY AWARDING EDUCATIONAL
- 2 SCHOLARSHIPS AND RESEARCH GRANTS AND PROVIDING FINANCIAL AID FOR
- 3 CONTINUED EDUCATION REQUIRED FOR MAINTAINING NURSING LICENSURE.
- 4 (3) THE MICHIGAN NURSES FUND-RAISING REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL
- 5 NOT BE DEVELOPED UNTIL A START-UP FEE OF \$15,000.00 IS PAID TO THE
- 6 DEPARTMENT TO COVER THE COSTS OF DEVELOPING AND PRODUCING THE
- 7 MICHIGAN NURSES FUND-RAISING REGISTRATION PLATE. THIS START-UP FEE
- 8 SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE TRANSPORTATION ADMINISTRATION
- 9 COLLECTION FUND ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 810B AND IS NONREFUNDABLE.
- 10 (4) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (5), THE MICHIGAN NURSES FUND-
- 11 RAISING REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL MEET OR EXCEED THE FOLLOWING SALES
- 12 GOALS:
- 13 (A) IN THE FIRST YEAR, 2,000 PLATES.
- 14 (B) IN THE SECOND AND EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR, 500 ORIGINAL
- 15 PLATES.
- 16 (5) IF SALES OF THE MICHIGAN NURSES FUND-RAISING REGISTRATION
- 17 PLATE FAIL TO SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (4), THE
- 18 DEPARTMENT SHALL DISCONTINUE THE SALE OF ORIGINAL MICHIGAN NURSES
- 19 FUND-RAISING REGISTRATION PLATES. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT
- 20 THE RENEWAL OF A MICHIGAN NURSES FUND-RAISING REGISTRATION PLATE.
- 21 Enacting section 1. Enacting section 1 of 2000 PA 77, is
- 22 repealed.
