## **HOUSE BILL No. 4571**

March 24, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Meyer, Taub, Wenke, Nofs and Stahl and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled

"Michigan election law,"

by amending section 737a (MCL 168.737a), as added by 1996 PA 461.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 737a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 2 the board of election inspectors shall not count a write-in vote
- 3 for -any A person unless that person has filed a declaration of
- 4 intent to be a write-in candidate as provided in this section. The
- 5 write-in candidate shall file the declaration of intent to be a
- 6 write-in candidate with the filing official for that elective
- 7 office on or before 4 p.m. on the Friday immediately preceding
- 8 BEFORE the election. The secretary of state, immediately after the
- 9 4 p.m. filing deadline under this subsection, shall prepare and

- 1 cause to be HAVE delivered a list of all persons who have filed a
- 2 declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate -pursuant to
- 3 UNDER this subsection, if any, to the appropriate county clerks. A
- 4 filing official other than the secretary of state who receives a
- 5 declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate or list of persons
- 6 who filed a declaration of intent from another filing official
- 7 pursuant to UNDER this subsection shall prepare and -cause to be
- 8 HAVE delivered a list of all persons who have filed a declaration

- 10 subsection to the board of election inspectors in the appropriate
- 11 precincts before the close of the polls on election day.
- 12 (2) If a candidate whose name is printed on the official
- 13 ballot for the election dies or is otherwise disqualified on or
- 14 after the Wednesday immediately -preceding-BEFORE the election,
- 15 the requirement of filing a declaration of intent to be a write-in
- 16 candidate under subsection (1) does not apply to a write-in
- 17 candidate. If a death or disqualification has occurred as described
- 18 in this subsection, the board of election inspectors shall count
- 19 all write-in votes for write-in candidates for the office sought by
- 20 the deceased or disqualified candidate.
- 21 (3) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to a write-in
- 22 candidate for precinct delegate. The board of election inspectors
- 23 shall not count a write-in vote for a write-in candidate for
- 24 precinct delegate unless that candidate has filed a declaration of
- 25 intent to be a write-in candidate as provided in this subsection. A
- 26 write-in candidate for precinct delegate shall file a declaration
- 27 of intent to be a write-in candidate with the appropriate city or

- 1 township clerk for that precinct on or before 4 p.m. on the Friday
- 2 immediately -preceding- BEFORE the election or with the board of
- 3 election inspectors in the appropriate precinct before the close of
- 4 the polls on election day. A city or township clerk who receives a
- 5 declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate from a write-in
- 6 candidate for precinct delegate -pursuant to- UNDER this subsection
- 7 shall prepare and —cause to be— HAVE delivered a list of all
- 8 persons who have filed a declaration of intent to be a write-in
- 9 candidate pursuant to UNDER this subsection to the board of
- 10 election inspectors in the appropriate precincts before the close

- 12 (4) SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) DO NOT APPLY TO A WRITE-IN
- 13 CANDIDATE FOR BOARD MEMBER OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION.
- 14 THE BOARD OF ELECTION INSPECTORS SHALL NOT COUNT A WRITE-IN VOTE
- 15 FOR A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FOR BOARD MEMBER OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 16 BOARD OF EDUCATION UNLESS THAT CANDIDATE HAS FILED A DECLARATION OF
- 17 INTENT TO BE A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION. A
- 18 WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FOR BOARD MEMBER OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF
- 19 EDUCATION SHALL FILE A DECLARATION OF INTENT TO BE A WRITE-IN
- 20 CANDIDATE WITH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION COORDINATOR ON OR
- 21 BEFORE 4 P.M. ON THE FOURTEENTH DAY IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE
- 22 ELECTION. A FILING OFFICIAL WHO RECEIVES A DECLARATION OF INTENT TO
- 23 BE A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FROM A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FOR BOARD MEMBER
- 24 OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL
- 25 PREPARE AND HAVE DELIVERED A LIST OF ALL PERSONS WHO HAVE FILED A
- 26 DECLARATION OF INTENT TO BE A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE UNDER THIS
- 27 SUBSECTION TO THE BOARD OF ELECTION INSPECTORS IN THE APPROPRIATE

- 1 PRECINCTS BEFORE THE CLOSE OF THE POLLS ON ELECTION DAY.
- 2 (5) -(4)— The secretary of state shall prescribe forms for
- 3 the declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate. Clerks shall
- 4 maintain a supply of declaration of intent to be a write-in
- 5 candidate forms in the clerk's office and make the forms available
- 6 in the polling places during the August primary REGULAR ELECTION
- 7 for this purpose. The declaration of intent to be a write-in
- 8 candidate form shall include all of the following information:
- **9** (a) The name of the person intending to be a write-in
- 10 candidate.
- 11 (b) The elective office that the person seeks as a write-in
- 12 candidate.
- 13 (c) The residence address of the person seeking elective
- 14 office as a write-in candidate.
- 15 (d) Any other OTHER information the secretary of state
- 16 considers appropriate.
