A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 143a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 143A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL OR RENT A RESTRICTED
- 2 VIDEO GAME TO A PERSON WHO IS LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE. AS USED IN
- 3 THIS SECTION, "RESTRICTED VIDEO GAME" MEANS A VIDEO GAME RATED "AO"
- 4 OR "M" BY THE ENTERTAINMENT SOFTWARE RATING BOARD.
- 5 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 6 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR
- 7 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
