## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 143A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL OR RENT A RESTRICTED
- 2 VIDEO GAME TO A PERSON WHO IS LESS THAN 17 YEARS OF AGE. AS USED IN
- 3 THIS SECTION, "RESTRICTED VIDEO GAME" MEANS A VIDEO GAME RATED "AO"
- 4 OR "M" BY THE ENTERTAINMENT SOFTWARE RATING BOARD.
- 5 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A
- 6 STATE CIVIL INFRACTION AND MAY BE ORDERED TO PAY A FINE OF NOT MORE
- 7 THAN \$1,000.00.
