THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

board shall not be directly or indirectly interested in a contract
with the board. Except for the per diem allowance provided in
subsection (2) OR THE SALARY PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (3), a
member of the first class school district board shall not receive
compensation for services rendered to the board.

(2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and subsection (3), each first class school district board member shall be paid a per diem allowance of \$30.00 for each board meeting and
