## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6510. (1) An individual taken, or seeking voluntary
- 2 admission under section 6506, to emergency medical service , or
- 3 transfer facility shall have his or her possessions inventoried and
- 4 held in a secure place. THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL SIGN THE INVENTORY
  - RECORD AND THE FACILITY SHALL MAINTAIN THE ORIGINAL AND PROVIDE THE
  - INDIVIDUAL WITH A COPY.
- 7 (2) These possessions shall be returned to the individual when
- 8 the individual is released. THESE POSSESSIONS MAY BE RELEASED TO
- 9 ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IF SPECIFICALLY REQUESTED BY THE INDIVIDUAL.
