

# HOUSE BILL No. 4771

May 11, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Virgil Smith, Lipsey, Clack, Murphy, Hunter, Alma Smith, McConico, Gillard, Waters, Miller and Cheeks and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 16x of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16x), as amended  
by 2003 PA 313.
