## **HOUSE BILL No. 5077**

August 3, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Stakoe and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 7453 (MCL 333.7453), as added by 1988 PA 139; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7453. (1) Subject to subsection (2), a A person shall 2 not sell or offer for sale drug paraphernalia. -, knowing that the 3 drug paraphernalia will be used to plant, propagate, cultivate, 4 grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, 5 prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, conceal, inject, inquest, inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body 7 a controlled substance. (2) Before a person is arrested for a violation of subsection

- 1 (1), the attorney general or a prosecuting attorney shall notify
- 2 the person in writing, not less than 2 business days before the
- 3 person is to be arrested, that the person is in possession of
- 4 specific, defined material that has been determined by the attorney
- 5 general or prosecuting attorney to be drug paraphernalia. The
- 6 notice also shall request that the person refrain from selling or
- 7 offering for sale the material and shall state that if the person
- 8 complies with the notice, no arrest will be made for a violation of
- 9 subsection (1).
- 10 (3) If a person complies with a notice sent under subsection
- 11 (2), the compliance is a complete defense for the person against a
- 12 prosecution under section 7453, as long as the compliance
- 13 continues.
