THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 903. (1) A person who, WITH INTENT TO USE THE FALSE

- 4 not limited to an application for any type of driver license,
- 5 dealer license, vehicle certificate of title, vehicle registration,
 - vehicle inspection, self-insurance, personal information, or
 - commercial driver training school, is guilty of a felony PUNISHABLE
- BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE
