## **HOUSE BILL No. 5183**

September 15, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Hune, Farrah, Gaffney and Vander Veen and referred to the Committee on Senior Health, Security, and Retirement.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 20173a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 20173A. (1) A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY THAT IS A NURSING
- 2 HOME, COUNTY MEDICAL CARE FACILITY, OR HOME FOR THE AGED SHALL
- 3 PROVIDE EACH EMPLOYEE, WHO PROVIDES DIRECT SERVICES TO PATIENTS OR
- 4 RESIDENTS WITHIN THAT HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY, AT HIRE WITH A
- 5 WRITTEN NOTICE OF ITS SUBSTANCE ABUSE TESTING POLICY. THE WRITTEN
- 6 NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) GROUNDS ON WHICH AN EMPLOYEE MAY BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT TO
- 8 A TEST.

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- 1 (B) CONSEQUENCES FOR REFUSING TO SUBMIT TO A TEST.
- 2 (C) APPEAL PROCEDURE FOR CHALLENGING THE RESULTS OF THE TEST.
- 3 (D) NOTICE AND TESTING REQUIREMENTS.
- 4 (2) A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY THAT IS A NURSING HOME, COUNTY
- 5 MEDICAL CARE FACILITY, OR HOME FOR THE AGED MAY REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE
- 6 WHO PROVIDES DIRECT SERVICES TO PATIENTS OR RESIDENTS IN THE HEALTH
- 7 FACILITY OR AGENCY TO SUBMIT TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE TESTING AS A
- 8 CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT IF THAT HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY HAS
- 9 PROBABLE CAUSE TO SUSPECT THE EMPLOYEE OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE.
- 10 (3) A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY THAT REQUIRES AN EMPLOYEE TO
- 11 SUBMIT TO A TEST UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY ALL COSTS INVOLVED IN
- 12 THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE TEST.
