A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act," by amending section 46 (MCL 400.46).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1	Sec. 46. (1) The administration of the powers and duties of
2	the county department shall be vested in a county - social services
3	FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY board of $\frac{-3}{-}$ 5 members, appointed from
4	persons residing within the county and not holding an elective
5	office, for 3-year terms as follows: -2 — 4 members shall be
6	appointed by the county board of commissioners, and 1 member by the
7	DEPARTMENT directorof social services. Members appointed before
8	October 27, 1965, shall continue in office until the expiration of
9	their terms and until successors are appointed and qualified. Each
.0	member shall qualify by taking and filing with the county clerk the

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- 1 constitutional oath of office, and shall hold office until the
- 2 appointment and qualification of a successor. Vacancies in the
- 3 membership of the board shall be filled for the expiration of the
- 4 unexpired term, in the same manner as provided for appointment of
- 5 the original members.
- 6 (2) The business -which THAT the county -social services
- 7 FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY board may perform shall be conducted at
- 8 a public meeting of the county social services FAMILY
- 9 INDEPENDENCE AGENCY board held in compliance with Act No. 267 of
- 10 the Public Acts of 1976 THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL
- 11 15.261 TO 15.275. Public notice of the time, date, and place of the
- 12 meeting shall be given in the manner required by Act No. 267 of
- 13 the Public Acts of 1976 THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL
- 14 15.261 TO 15.275. A majority of the board constitutes a quorum for
- 15 the transaction of business. The board shall meet on the call of
- 16 the chairperson, or on a written request to the chairperson signed
- 17 by $\frac{2}{3}$ members of the board, or at times and places as prescribed
- 18 by the rules of the board. The board shall hold not less than 12
- 19 meetings each fiscal year with an interval of not more than 5 weeks
- 20 between 2 meetings.
- 21 (3) At the first meeting following the appointment of a new
- 22 member to the board, the members shall choose 1 member as
- 23 chairperson, who shall continue to act as chairperson of the board
- 24 until the selection of a successor.
- 25 (4) If a member of the county —social services— FAMILY
- 26 INDEPENDENCE AGENCY board, upon receiving notification, fails to
- 27 attend 3 consecutive regularly scheduled meetings of the board, the

- **8** (5) Members of the board shall be reimbursed for necessary
- 9 travel and other expenses, and shall be paid -such AN amount -as

- 12 (6) Except as prescribed in sections 35 and 64, a writing
- 13 prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or retained by the
- 14 county social services FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY board in the
- 15 performance of an official function shall be made available to the
- 16 public in compliance with Act No. 442 of the Public Acts of 1976
