1 TITLE

An act to provide for planning, mitigation, response, and recovery from natural and human-made disaster within OR OUTSIDE OF this state; to create the Michigan emergency management advisory council and prescribe its powers and duties; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and officials; to prescribe immunities and liabilities; to provide for the acceptance of gifts; AND to repeal —certain—acts and parts of

- 2 SEC. 12A. (1) A MUNICIPALITY MAY GRANT AN EMPLOYEE LEAVE WITH

- 4 OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "DISASTER OR
