- 2 THE COUNTY TREASURER, CITY CLERK, CITY TREASURER, OR TOWNSHIP
- 3 TREASURER SHALL ALSO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE DOG OWNER REGARDING
- 4 BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) MICROCHIP IMPLANTATION AND REGISTRATION FOR DOGS.
- 6 (B) TATTOO IDENTIFICATION AND REGISTRATION FOR DOGS.
