A bill to amend 2002 PA 591, entitled "Michigan nursing scholarship act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 390.1184).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. The authority may award a scholarship under this act
- 2 to an individual determined by the authority to meet all of the
- 3 following eligibility criteria:
- 4 (a) Is a United States citizen or permanent resident of AN
- 5 ALIEN LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE INTO the United
- 6 States.
 - (b) Has resided continuously in this state for the 12 months
- 8 immediately preceding the date of his or her application and is not
 - a resident of any other state.

- 1 (c) Is enrolled or has been accepted into a nursing program.
- 2 (d) Has signed a written scholarship agreement with the
- 3 authority stating the individual's intention to pursue nursing as a
- 4 career and to serve in eligible employment in this state for not
- 5 less than 1 of the following periods:
- 6 (i) One year if the individual received scholarship assistance
- 7 under this act in 1 academic year of full-time enrollment in a
- 8 nursing program.
- 9 (ii) Two years if the individual received scholarship
- 10 assistance under this act in 2 academic years of full-time
- 11 enrollment in a nursing program.
- 12 (iii) Three years if the individual received scholarship
- 13 assistance under this act in 3 academic years of full-time
- 14 enrollment in a nursing program.
- 15 (iv) Four years if the individual received scholarship
- 16 assistance under this act in 4 academic years of full-time
- 17 enrollment in a nursing program.
- (e) Is in compliance with this act and the rules promulgated
- 19 under this act.
- (f) Has not been convicted of a felony involving an assault,
- 21 physical injury, or death.
- 22 (g) Meets any other standards established in rules promulgated
- 23 by the authority under section 3.
