

HOUSE BILL No. 5346

October 20, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Stahl, Emmons, Sheltroun, Booher, Hoogendyk,
Hummel, Nitz, Baxter, Drolet and Mayes and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 412, entitled

"An act to provide for the suppression of serious diseases among bees; to prescribe certain powers and duties of the director of the department of agriculture; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 11 (MCL 286.811), as amended by 1993 PA 108.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 11. ~~(1)~~ If the director determines that there exists in
2 this state or in any other state, territory, or district a serious
3 bee disease, or an exotic strain of bees, the director may impose
4 and enforce a quarantine restricting the transportation into,
5 within, or through the state, of bees, bee products, or article of
6 any character capable of carrying bee diseases.

7 ~~(2) The director may promulgate rules to carry out this act,~~
8 ~~including rules to provide for seizure, inspection, disinfection,~~

1 ~~destruction, or other disposition of bees, beekeeping equipment, or~~
