## **HOUSE BILL No. 5412**

November 8, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Gaffney, Accavitti, Gleason, Stewart and Ward and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Great Lakes, Land Use, and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 11511a (MCL 324.11511a), as added by 2004 PA 38; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 11511a. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this 2 part, and except as otherwise provided in this section, the 3 department shall not issue a permit to construct a landfill if the administratively complete application for such permit was received 4 after January 1, 2004 and before January 1,  $\frac{2006}{}$  2010.
  - (2) The department may issue a permit for a design modification to an existing landfill if the modification does not result in a net increase in remaining disposal capacity as calculated under section 11507a.

- 1 (3) The department may issue a permit to construct an
- 2 expansion to an existing landfill if the applicant demonstrates
- 3 that the landfill has less than -5— 2 years of remaining disposal
- 4 capacity as <u>defined in</u> CALCULATED UNDER section 11507a and the
- 5 application otherwise meets the requirements of this part. A permit
- 6 issued under this subsection shall provide not more than a total of
- 7 10 8 years of remaining disposal capacity when added to the
- 8 remaining disposal capacity existing prior to issuance of the
- 9 permit. The amount of time of remaining disposal capacity shall be
- 10 calculated based on the average of the 3 prior years of waste
- 11 receipt as reported under section 11507a.
- 12 (4) The department may issue a permit to construct a type III
- 13 landfill that is a captive facility -as defined in section
- 14  $\frac{11525a(10)}{1}$  if the application otherwise meets the requirements of
- 15 this part.
- 16 (5) The department may issue a permit to construct an
- 17 expansion of an existing landfill if the expansion is authorized
- 18 pursuant to a host community agreement in existence on the
- 19 effective date of this section.
- 20 (6) By January 1, 2005, the department shall submit to the
- 21 legislature a report providing recommendations for amending the
- 22 solid waste planning and disposal area siting provisions of this
- 23 part. The report shall also recommend methods for securing
- 24 reasonable and necessary regional and statewide disposal capacity
- 25 considering the paramount public concern in the conservation of the
- 26 natural resources of the state. The department shall prepare this
- 27 report based on consultation with affected parties.

- 2 (A) "CAPTIVE FACILITY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 3 11525A.
- 4 (B) -(a) "Existing landfill" means a landfill that was
- 5 licensed under this part to receive waste as of October 1, 2003.
- 6 (b) "Host community agreement" means a written, legally
- 7 binding agreement, between the owner or operator of a landfill and
- 8 the county or municipality in which an expansion of that landfill
- 9 will be located, governing the operation, location, or development
- 10 of the landfill in that county or municipality.
- 11 (6) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010.
- 12 Enacting section 1. Enacting section 1 of 2004 PA 38 is
- 13 repealed.
