HOUSE BILL No. 5511

December 14, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Ward, Farhat, Elsenheimer, Gillard, Accavitti, Sheltrown, Espinoza, Stakoe, Miller, Pavlov, Green, Sak, Vagnozzi, Schuitmaker, Taub, Jones, Baxter, Kahn, Gaffney and Waters and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2001 PA 124, and by adding section 811o.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 811e. (1) The secretary of state may develop a Michigan university fund-raising registration plate as described in this section, and a matching Michigan university collector plate as described in section 811g.
 - (2) The secretary of state may develop 1 or more limited term registration plates to recognize a state-sponsored event, a Michigan university, or an accomplishment or occasion of a Michigan university.

- 1 (3) The secretary of state may, at any 1 time, develop -not
- 2 more than 7 different state-sponsored fund-raising registration
- 3 plates as described in this section, and matching state-sponsored
- 4 collector plates as described in section 811g. As used in this
- 5 section, "state-sponsored fund-raising registration plate" means a
- 6 fund-raising registration plate authorized by a public act to raise
- 7 funds for a state-sponsored goal. The public act shall, at a
- 8 minimum, do all of the following:
- 9 (a) Identify the purpose of the state-sponsored fund-raising
- 10 registration plate.
- 11 (b) Create a fund or designate an existing fund to receive the
- 12 money raised through the sale of state-sponsored fund-raising
- 13 registration plates and matching collector plates.
- 14 (c) If a fund is created, name the person or entity
- 15 responsible for administering the fund.
- 16 (4) The secretary of state may develop, promote, and market
- 17 the fund-raising registration plates and matching collector plates
- 18 issued under this section with the funds available through service
- 19 fees.
- 20 (5) If the design or logo of a Michigan university fund-
- 21 raising registration plate or a state-sponsored fund-raising
- 22 registration plate uses 1 or more designs, trade names, trademarks,
- 23 service marks, emblems, symbols, or other images that are owned by
- 24 the Michigan university that is requesting the Michigan university
- 25 fund-raising plate, the person or entity that is sponsoring a
- 26 state-sponsored fund-raising plate, or any other person or entity,
- 27 the Michigan university or sponsoring person or entity shall grant

- 1 to or obtain for the secretary of state both of the following
- 2 pursuant ACCORDING to a written agreement between the parties:
- 3 (a) A nonexclusive worldwide license to use those designs,
- 4 trade names, trademarks, service marks, emblems, symbols, or other
- 5 images on and in conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale,
- 6 or copyrighting of the registration plate or image of the
- 7 registration plate.
- **8** (b) The authority to merchandise the registration plate or an
- 9 image of the registration plate.
- 10 (6) In using or employing a design, trade name, trademark,
- 11 service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image on and in
- 12 conjunction with the marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or
- 13 merchandising of a registration plate or image of the registration
- 14 plate, the secretary of state may alter the size of the design,
- 15 trade name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other
- 16 image but shall not change the color or design of the design, trade
- 17 name, trademark, service mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image
- 18 without the prior written consent of the respective Michigan
- 19 university or sponsoring person or entity. The secretary of state
- 20 shall not use or employ a design, trade name, trademark, service
- 21 mark, emblem, symbol, logo, or other image on and in conjunction
- 22 with the marketing, promotion, sale, copyrighting, or merchandising
- 23 of a registration plate or an image of the registration plate in
- 24 any manner that is offensive to the Michigan university or
- 25 sponsoring person or entity that complies with subsection (5).
- 26 (7) As used in this section, "Michigan university fund-raising
- 27 registration plate" means a fund-raising registration plate that is

- 1 issued under this section at the request of a Michigan university.
- 2 SEC. 8110. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
- 3 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE A THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING PLATE UNDER
- 4 SECTION 811F AND A MATCHING THIN BLUE LINE COLLECTOR PLATE AS
- 5 PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 811G. THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN CONJUNCTION
- 6 WITH THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN SHALL DESIGN THE PLATES, HAVING
- 7 THE WORDS "THIN BLUE LINE" AND "MICHIGAN" ON THE PLATES.
- 8 (2) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER
- 9 THIS ACT MAY APPLY, ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE,
- 10 FOR A THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING PLATE AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION
- 11 811F INSTEAD OF A STANDARD REGISTRATION PLATE.
- 12 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
- 13 FROM THE SALE OF THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING AND COLLECTOR PLATES
- 14 TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY AS
- 15 FOLLOWS:
- 16 (A) \$15.00 TO THE THIN BLUE LINE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER
- 17 SUBSECTION (4).
- 18 (B) \$5.00 TO THE POLICE OFFICER'S AND FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR
- 19 TUITION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (7).
- 20 (C) \$5.00 TO THE CRIME VICTIM'S RIGHTS FUND CREATED IN SECTION
- 21 4 OF 1989 PA 196, MCL 780.904.
- 22 (4) THE THIN BLUE LINE FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
- 23 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
- 24 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
- 25 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
- 26 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
- 27 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN

- 1 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 2 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND ON A
- 3 QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN, P.O. BOX 415,
- 4 HOWELL, MICHIGAN 48844-0415 OR A SUCCESSOR ADDRESS. BEGINNING NOT
- 5 LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2007, AND ANNUALLY AFTER THAT, AN
- 6 ORGANIZATION RECEIVING MONEY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL REPORT TO THE
- 7 STATE TREASURER. A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE A
- 8 SUMMARY OF EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY
- 9 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 10 (6) THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY
- 11 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION SOLELY TO ASSIST AND SUPPORT THE
- 12 FAMILIES OF INJURED OR DECEASED OFFICERS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 13 AGENCIES WITHIN THIS STATE.
- 14 (7) THE POLICE OFFICER'S AND FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR TUITION
- 15 FUND IS ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER
- 16 MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO
- 17 THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE
- 18 FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND
- 19 EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS. MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF
- 20 THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE
- 21 GENERAL FUND.
- 22 (8) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND ON A
- 23 QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE. BEGINNING NOT
- 24 LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2007, THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL
- 25 SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY OF THE EXPENDITURES DURING
- 26 THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 27 (9) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY

- 1 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION SOLELY TO ASSIST AND SUPPORT THE POLICE
- 2 OFFICER'S AND FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR TUITION ACT, 1996 PA 195, MCL
