## **HOUSE BILL No. 5544**

January 11, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Stakoe and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 20174.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 20174. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER THIS
- 2 SECTION, A HOSPITAL, FREESTANDING SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY, OR
- 3 ANY OTHER SIMILAR ENTITY THAT UTILIZES SURGICAL TECHNOLOGISTS SHALL
- 4 NOT EMPLOY, INDEPENDENTLY CONTRACT WITH, OR GRANT CLINICAL
- 5 PRIVILEGES TO AN INDIVIDUAL AS A SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST UNLESS THAT
  - INDIVIDUAL SATISFIES EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:
  - (A) HOLDS A NATIONAL CERTIFICATION ESTABLISHED BY THE LIAISON
- 8 COUNCIL ON CERTIFICATION FOR THE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST.
  - (B) HAS COMPLETED A PROGRAM FOR SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY ACCREDITED
  - BY THE COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION OF ALLIED HEALTH EDUCATION

- 2 (C) HAS COMPLETED AN ACCREDITED TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SURGICAL
- 3 TECHNOLOGISTS IN THE ARMED FORCES OR IN A HOSPITAL OR FREESTANDING
- 4 SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY.
- 5 (D) HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST
- 6 CERTIFYING EXAM APPROVED BY THE LIAISON COUNCIL ON CERTIFICATION
- 7 FOR THE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST.
- 8 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
- 9 EMPLOYED BY OR UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR WHO IS
- 10 CURRENTLY EMPLOYED BY OR UNDER CONTRACT WITH A HOSPITAL,
- 11 FREESTANDING SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY, OR OTHER ENTITY AND HAS
- 12 BEEN EMPLOYED BY OR UNDER CONTRACT WITH THAT ENTITY FOR NOT LESS
- 13 THAN 18 MONTHS OVER THE COURSE OF THE 3 YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING
- 14 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION.
- 15 (3) A HOSPITAL, FREESTANDING SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY, OR
- 16 OTHER SIMILAR ENTITY THAT UTILIZES SURGICAL TECHNOLOGISTS MAY
- 17 PETITION THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT FOR A WAIVER FROM THE
- 18 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1) IF THAT ENTITY IS UNABLE TO EMPLOY A
- 19 SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF SURGICAL TECHNOLOGISTS WHO MEET THE
- 20 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1). THE DIRECTOR SHALL GRANT THE WAIVER
- 21 IF THE HOSPITAL, FREESTANDING SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY, OR
- 22 OTHER ENTITY CAN DEMONSTRATE THAT IT MADE A DILIGENT AND THOROUGH
- 23 EFFORT TO EMPLOY SURGICAL TECHNOLOGISTS THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS
- 24 OF SUBSECTION (1). A WAIVER GRANTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS VALID
- 25 FOR NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS. THE DEPARTMENT MAY RENEW THE WAIVER,
- 26 BUT THE WAIVER SHALL NOT EXCEED 12 MONTHS.
