A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled
"General sales tax act,"
(MCL 205.1 to 205.78) by adding section 4cc.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 4CC. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006, THE SALE OF TANGIBLE
2 PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS AN ENERGY CONSERVATION PRODUCT THAT IS TO
3 BE AFFIXED TO, INSTALLED IN, OR MADE A STRUCTURAL PART OF A
4 BUILDING IS EXEMPT FROM THE TAX UNDER THIS ACT. AS USED IN THIS
5 SECTION, "ENERGY CONSERVATION PRODUCT" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED
6 TO, INSULATION, WEATHER STRIPPING, STORM WINDOWS, AND STORM DOORS.
