HOUSE BILL No. 5553

January 18, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Hune, Gaffney and Mortimer and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Policy.

A bill to amend 1988 PA 57, entitled

"An act to provide for the incorporation by 2 or more municipalities of certain authorities for the purpose of providing emergency services to municipalities; to provide for the powers and duties of authorities and of certain state and local agencies and officers; to guarantee certain labor contracts and employment rights in regard to the formation and reorganization of authorities; to provide for certain condemnation proceedings; to provide for the levy of property taxes for certain purposes; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,"

by amending the title and sections 5 and 9 (MCL 124.605 and 124.609), the title as amended by 1999 PA 167.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 11 political subdivisions, and other authorities in those
- 12 investigations.
- 13 (G) (e) Subject to the terms and conditions prescribed in
- 14 section 10, hire employees, attorneys, accountants, and consultants
- 15 as the authority considers necessary to carry out the purposes of
- 16 the authority.
