- 3 SEC. 14001. A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, POSSESS
- 4 FOR SALE, GIVE AWAY, USE, OR PRESCRIBE ANY PRODUCT USED FOR THE
- 5 TREATMENT OF LICE OR SCABIES IN HUMAN BEINGS THAT CONTAINS THE
- 6 PESTICIDE CHEMICAL LINDANE.
- 7 SEC. 14005. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON
- WHO VIOLATES THIS PART IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR.
