

# HOUSE BILL No. 5680

February 15, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Lemmons, III, Lemmons, Jr., Drolet, Cushingberry and Sheltroun and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled  
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"  
by amending section 943 (MCL 600.943); and to repeal acts and parts  
of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 943. The board of law examiners has the authority to  
2       examine, or to cause to be examined, any school, college, **OR** junior  
3       college ~~—, or law school—~~ for the purpose of determining whether  
4       the standards of education and training required for admission to  
5       the bar are being maintained, and to exclude from the bar  
6       examination any person who was a student therein at the time any  
7       such educational institution is found to have been disqualified or  
8       of questionable reputation. The board of law examiners may exclude  
9       from the bar examination any person who was a student in any ~~such~~

1 educational institution if ~~such~~ **THAT** educational institution  
2 refuses to allow the examination.

3 Enacting section 1. Section 940 of the revised judicature act  
4 of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.940, is repealed.
