A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding sections 217g and 217h.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 217G. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL, FURNISH, POSSESS,
- 2 WEAR, EXHIBIT, DISPLAY, OR USE THE BADGE, PATCH, OR UNIFORM, OR
- 3 FACSIMILE OF THE BADGE, PATCH, OR UNIFORM, OF ANY FIRE DEPARTMENT
- 4 OR MEDICAL FIRST RESPONSE SERVICE UNLESS 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING
- 5 APPLY:
- 6 (A) THE PERSON RECEIVING OR POSSESSING THE BADGE, PATCH,
- 7 UNIFORM, OR FACSIMILE IS AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE OR POSSESS THE
- 8 BADGE, PATCH, UNIFORM, OR FACSIMILE BY THE CHIEF OFFICER OF THE
  - FIRE DEPARTMENT OR MEDICAL FIRST RESPONSE SERVICE.
