## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 107A. IN ESTABLISHING FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY FOR THE
- 2 MEDICALLY INDIGENT, RESOURCES SHALL BE DISREGARDED ACCORDING TO
- 3 STANDARDS ESTABLISHED FOR THE RELATED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- 4 FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
- 5 ONLY, THE VALUE OF AN ANNUITY AS A RESOURCE WILL ONLY BE
- 6 DISREGARDED IF AN IRREVOCABLE ANNUITY IS COMMERCIALLY ISSUED BY AN
- 7 AGENT LICENSED IN THE UNITED STATES AND RETURNS THE PRINCIPAL AND

- 1 PURCHASER'S LIFE EXPECTANCY. THE DEPARTMENT HAS FIRST PRIORITY TO
