A bill to amend 1846 RS 12, entitled
"Of certain state officers,"
(MCL 11.4 to 11.5) by adding section 6.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 6. TO PRESERVE PUBLIC CONFIDENCE IN THE PURITY OF
2 ELECTIONS, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT SERVE AS AN ACTUAL OR
3 HONORARY OFFICIAL IN THE CAMPAIGN OF A CANDIDATE FOR FEDERAL OR
4 STATE OFFICE THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF AN ELECTION IN THIS STATE,
5 UNLESS HE OR SHE IS THE CANDIDATE.
