## **HOUSE BILL No. 6185**

June 8, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Espinoza, Clemente, McDowell, Bieda, Anderson, Byrnes, Sak, Gleason and Leland and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled "Michigan military act,"

by amending section 251 (MCL 32.651), as amended by 1988 PA 246.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 251. (1) When the president calls or orders all or part 1 2 of the national quard into federal service in time of a national 3 emergency or when it appears that the national guard may be called to federal service, the THE governor, as commander-in-chief, may 4 5 activate within the military establishment such number of units to 6 be known as the Michigan - emergency volunteers - VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE, as the governor considers necessary for adequate emergency 7 8 assistance to the state. When activated by proper authority, the Michigan - emergency volunteers - VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE shall

- 1 perform only aid to civil authority missions formerly reserved
- 2 for the national guard— as determined by the department of military
- 3 AND VETERANS affairs in cooperation with the department of state
- 4 police and the state emergency preparedness plan. During times
- 5 other than a national emergency, organization of the Michigan
- 6 emergency volunteers VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE shall not exceed 15%
- 7 of the Michigan national guard authorized strength.
- 8 (2) Not later than 1 year after the effective date of the
- 9 amendatory act that added this subsection, and each year
- 10 thereafter, the department of military affairs shall report to the
- 11 standing committees of the senate and house of representatives that
- 12 are responsible for legislation concerning military affairs, and
- 13 the senate and house appropriations committees as to the proposed
- 14 and actual status of development of the Michigan emergency
- 15 volunteers. The reports shall include all of the following:
- 16 (a) Regulations or proposed regulations to define and limit
- 17 the type and duration of missions that may be undertaken by the
- 18 Michigan emergency volunteers.
- 19 (b) Proposals for meeting the training and equipment needs of
- 20 the Michigan emergency volunteers in fulfilling the missions that
- 21 may be undertaken, and a 3-year projection of the costs of that
- 22 training and equipment.
- 23 (c) A description of the requirements or proposed
- 24 requirements, including physical ability, for membership in the
- 25 Michigan emergency volunteers.
- 26 (d) Procedures that are used or are proposed to be used to
- 27 screen membership in the Michigan emergency volunteers as to

- 1 character and fitness, including standards that will ensure that no
- 2 person with a serious criminal record is a member.
- 3 (e) The plan detailing methods and procedures for the
- 4 coordination of the operations of the Michigan emergency volunteers
- 5 with the state police, local law enforcement agencies, and state
- 6 and federal disaster relief authorities.
- 7 (2) -(3) A list of former officers, warrant officers, and
- 8 enlisted personnel of the Michigan national guard shall be
- 9 maintained with their consent in the office of the adjutant general
- 10 to aid in forming the Michigan -emergency volunteers VOLUNTEER
- 11 DEFENSE FORCE.
- 12 (3) -(4)— The adjutant general may accept funding for the
- 13 Michigan emergency volunteers VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE from
- 14 sources other than the state or federal government but shall expend
- 15 those funds only pursuant to an appropriations act. The adjutant
- 16 general shall deposit -such THE funds in a special account within
- 17 the department of military AND VETERANS affairs.
- 18 (4)  $\overline{(5)}$  As used in this act, a reference to the Michigan
- 19 defense force means the Michigan emergency volunteers VOLUNTEER
- 20 DEFENSE FORCE.
- 21 (5)  $\overline{(6)}$  The department shall establish affirmative action
- 22 guidelines for membership goals in the Michigan -emergency
- 23 volunteers VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE. The department shall take all
- 24 steps necessary to carry out and implement those guidelines.
- 25 (6) -(7) Members of the Michigan -emergency volunteers
- 26 VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE shall not be equipped with any type of
- 27 weapon except under the following conditions:

- 1 (a) The president has called or ordered all or part of the
- 2 national guard into federal service in time of a national emergency
- 3 and the mission of the Michigan -emergency volunteers VOLUNTEER
- 4 DEFENSE FORCE to whom weapons are issued consists primarily of the
- 5 protection of public property.
- 6 (b) During training to be conducted by the national guard or
- 7 state police in the proper use of such weapons.
- 8 (7) NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
- 9 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER,
- 10 THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS SHALL REPORT TO THE
- 11 STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT
- 12 ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR LEGISLATION CONCERNING MILITARY AFFAIRS, AND
- 13 THE SENATE AND HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES AS TO THE PROPOSED
- 14 AND ACTUAL STATUS OF DEVELOPMENT OF THE MICHIGAN VOLUNTEER DEFENSE
- 15 FORCE. THE REPORTS SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (A) REGULATIONS OR PROPOSED REGULATIONS TO DEFINE AND LIMIT
- 17 THE TYPE AND DURATION OF MISSIONS THAT MAY BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE
- 18 MICHIGAN VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE.
- 19 (B) PROPOSALS FOR MEETING THE TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT NEEDS OF
- 20 THE MICHIGAN VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE IN FULFILLING THE MISSIONS
- 21 THAT MAY BE UNDERTAKEN, AND A 3-YEAR PROJECTION OF THE COSTS OF
- 22 THAT TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT.
- 23 (C) A DESCRIPTION OF THE REQUIREMENTS OR PROPOSED
- 24 REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING PHYSICAL ABILITY, FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE
- 25 MICHIGAN VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE.
- 26 (D) PROCEDURES THAT ARE USED OR ARE PROPOSED TO BE USED TO
- 27 SCREEN MEMBERSHIP IN THE MICHIGAN VOLUNTEER DEFENSE FORCE AS TO

- 1 CHARACTER AND FITNESS, INCLUDING STANDARDS THAT WILL ENSURE THAT NO
- 2 PERSON WITH A SERIOUS CRIMINAL RECORD IS A MEMBER.
- 3 (E) THE PLAN DETAILING METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE
- 4 COORDINATION OF THE OPERATIONS OF THE MICHIGAN VOLUNTEER DEFENSE
- 5 FORCE WITH THE STATE POLICE, LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, AND
- 6 STATE AND FEDERAL DISASTER RELIEF AUTHORITIES.
