- 1 not be construed as preventing the insurer from entering into 2 contracts with its agents for the payment of renewal commissions. (2) No such insurer shall grant any pension to any officer or 3 4 director thereof, or to any member of his family after his death, except that such insurer may in pursuance of the terms of a 5 retirement plan adopted by the board of directors of such insurer 6 and approved by the commissioner provide for any person, who is or 7 has been a salaried officer or employee of such insurer, a pension 8 payable at the time of his retirement by reason of age or 9 disability, and also life insurance benefits payable at his death. 10 11 (3) Such an insurer, in pursuance of the terms of a plan 12 adopted by its board of directors and approved by the commissioner, 13 may provide for any person who is or has been a salaried officer or employee of such insurer, hospital, surgical, medical and health 14 15 care benefits payable during his retirement, which plan shall provide equal benefits to all such officers, employees and their 16 17 dependents.
