

HOUSE BILL No. 6205

June 15, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Green and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending sections 17711 and 17721 (MCL 333.17711 and 333.17721),
section 17721 as amended by 1993 PA 79.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17711. (1) A person shall not engage in the practice of
- 2 pharmacy unless licensed or otherwise authorized by this article.
- 3 (2) THE FOLLOWING WORDS, TITLES, OR LETTERS OR A COMBINATION
- 4 THEREOF, WITH OR WITHOUT QUALIFYING WORDS OR PHRASES, ARE
- 5 RESTRICTED IN USE ONLY TO THOSE PERSONS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS PART
- 6 TO USE THE TERMS AND IN A WAY PRESCRIBED IN THIS PART: "PHARMACY",
- 7 "PHARMACIST", "APOTHECARY", "DRUGSTORE", "DRUGGIST", "MEDICINE
- 8 STORE", "PRESCRIPTIONS", AND "R.PH."

1 Sec. 17721. (1) The Michigan board of pharmacy is created in
2 the department and shall consist of the following 11 voting members
3 who shall meet the requirements of part 161: 6 pharmacists and 5
4 public members.

5 (2) THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD
6 CREATED UNDER THIS SECTION, EXCEPT THOSE APPOINTED TO FILL
7 VACANCIES, EXPIRE 4 YEARS AFTER APPOINTMENT ON JUNE 30 OF THE YEAR
8 IN WHICH THE TERM EXPIRES.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
10 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No. 6147(request no.
11 05150'05) of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into law.
