HOUSE BILL No. 6343

August 9, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Waters and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 28.291), as amended by 2005 PA 143.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) A person who is a resident of this state may apply
- 2 to the department of state for an official state personal
- 3 identification card. Upon application the applicant shall supply a
- 4 birth certificate attesting to his or her age or other sufficient
- 5 documents or identification as the secretary of state may require.
- 6 IF A PERSON SIGNS AN AFFIDAVIT STATING THAT HE OR SHE IS HOMELESS,
 - THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ACCEPT THAT PERSON'S THUMBPRINT AS

- 1 IDENTIFICATION OF THE PERSON. An application for a state personal
- 2 identification card shall be made in a manner prescribed by the
- 3 secretary of state and shall contain the applicant's full name,
- 4 date of birth, residence address, height, sex, eye color,
- 5 signature, and, beginning January 1, 2007, intent to be an organ
- 6 donor, and other information required or permitted on the official
- 7 state personal identification card. The applicant may provide a
- 8 mailing address if the applicant receives mail at an address
- 9 different from his or her residence address.
- 10 (2) The secretary of state shall not issue an official state
- 11 personal identification card to a person who holds an operator's or
- 12 chauffeur's license issued under the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
- 13 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, unless the license has been suspended,
- 14 revoked, or restricted.
