

HOUSE BILL No. 6343

August 9, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Waters and referred to the Committee on House Oversight, Elections, and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 28.291), as amended by 2005 PA 143.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) A person who is a resident of this state may apply
2 to the department of state for an official state personal
3 identification card. Upon application the applicant shall supply a
4 birth certificate attesting to his or her age or other sufficient
5 documents or identification as the secretary of state may require.
6 **IF A PERSON SIGNS AN AFFIDAVIT STATING THAT HE OR SHE IS HOMELESS,**
7 **THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ACCEPT THAT PERSON'S THUMBPRINT AS**

1 **IDENTIFICATION OF THE PERSON.** An application for a state personal
2 identification card shall be made in a manner prescribed by the
3 secretary of state and shall contain the applicant's full name,
4 date of birth, residence address, height, sex, eye color,
5 signature, and, beginning January 1, 2007, intent to be an organ
6 donor, and other information required or permitted on the official
7 state personal identification card. The applicant may provide a
8 mailing address if the applicant receives mail at an address
9 different from his or her residence address.

10 (2) The secretary of state shall not issue an official state
11 personal identification card to a person who holds an operator's or
12 chauffeur's license issued under the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
13 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, unless the license has been suspended,
14 revoked, or restricted.
