A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 5519.

- 1 SEC. 5519. (1) WITHIN 2 YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
- 2 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 3 PROMULGATE RULES SETTING FORTH SEPARATE EMISSION STANDARDS TO BE
- 4 MET BY EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) WOOD PELLET STOVES.
- 6 (B) CORN STOVES.
- 7 (C) MULTIPLE FUEL STOVES.
 - (2) A PERSON WHO INSTALLS A STOVE THAT, AT THE TIME OF
 INSTALLATION, DOES NOT MEET EMISSION STANDARDS PROMULGATED UNDER
 - SUBSECTION (1), OR WHO OPERATES SUCH A STOVE, IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A
