HOUSE BILL No. 6581

September 20, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Shaffer, Kooiman, Stahl and Pastor and referred to the Committee on Family and Children Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled

"The social welfare act,"

by amending section 57b (MCL 400.57b), as amended by 1999 PA 9.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 57b. (1) Subject to section 57l, an individual who meets
- 2 all of the following requirements is eligible for family
- 3 independence assistance:
- 4 (a) Is a member of a family or a family independence
- 5 assistance group.
- **6** (b) Is a member of a program group whose income and assets
- 7 are less than the income and asset limits set by the -family
- 8 independence agency DEPARTMENT.
- (c) In the case of a minor parent, meets the requirements of
- 10 subsection (2).

- 1 (d) Is a United States citizen, a permanent resident alien,
- 2 or a refugee.
- 3 (e) Is a resident of this state as described in section 32.
- 4 (f) Meets any other eligibility criterion required for the
- 5 receipt of federal or state funds or determined by the -family
- 6 independence agency DEPARTMENT to be necessary for the
- 7 accomplishment of the goals of the family independence program.
- **8** (2) A minor parent and the minor parent's child shall not
- 9 receive family independence assistance unless they live in an
- 10 adult-supervised household. The family independence assistance
- 11 shall be paid on behalf of the minor parent and child to an adult
- 12 in the adult-supervised household. Child care in conjunction with
- 13 participation in education, employment readiness, training, or
- 14 employment programs, -which- THAT have been approved by the
- 15 family independence agency DEPARTMENT, shall be provided for the
- 16 minor parent's child. The minor parent and child shall live with
- 17 the minor parent's parent, stepparent, or legal guardian unless
- 18 the family independence agency DEPARTMENT determines that there
- 19 is good cause for not requiring the minor parent and child to
- 20 live with a parent, stepparent, or legal guardian. The -family
- 21 independence agency DEPARTMENT shall determine the circumstances
- 22 that constitute good cause, based on a parent's, stepparent's, or
- 23 guardian's unavailability or unwillingness or based on a
- 24 reasonable belief that there is physical, sexual, or substance
- 25 abuse, or domestic violence, occurring in the household, or that
- 26 there is other risk to the physical or emotional health or safety
- 27 of the minor parent or child. If the <u>family independence agency</u>

- 1 DEPARTMENT determines that there is good cause for not requiring
- 2 a minor parent to live with a parent, stepparent, or legal
- 3 guardian, the minor parent and child shall live in another adult-
- 4 supervised household. A local office director may waive the
- 5 requirement set forth in this subsection with respect to a minor
- 6 parent who is at least 17 years of age, attending secondary
- 7 school full-time, and participating in a **DEPARTMENT** service plan
- 8 of the family independence agency or a teen parenting program,
- 9 if moving would require the minor parent to change schools.
- 10 (3) IN DETERMINING A PROGRAM GROUP'S FAMILY INDEPENDENCE
- 11 PROGRAM ASSISTANCE MONTHLY PAYMENT STANDARD, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 12 NOT TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION IN ITS CALCULATION OF THE PAYMENT
- 13 STANDARD THE GEOGRAPHICAL AREA OR SHELTER AREA IN WHICH THE
- 14 PROGRAM GROUP RESIDES. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ADJUST A PROGRAM
- 15 GROUP'S FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE PAYMENT STANDARD
- 16 BASED ON WHETHER A RECIPIENT IS EXEMPT FROM WORK FIRST
- 17 REQUIREMENTS UNDER SECTION 57F.
- 18 (4) THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE MONTHLY
- 19 PAYMENT STANDARD FOR HOUSEHOLDS IN WHICH ONLY THE ELIGIBLE
- 20 CHILDREN ARE COUNTED IN DETERMINING FAMILY SIZE, OR IF THE
- 21 GRANTEE IS RECEIVING SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME, SHALL BE PAID
- 22 AT AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT PER FAMILY SIZE LISTED AS
- 23 FOLLOWS:

- 6 (5) FOR ALL OTHER INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FAMILY
- 7 INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM ASSISTANCE, THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM
- 8 ASSISTANCE MONTHLY PAYMENT STANDARD SHALL BE PAID AT AN AMOUNT
- 9 NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT PER FAMILY SIZE LISTED AS FOLLOWS:

- 18 (6) FOR THE PURPOSES OF DETERMINING THE PAYMENT STANDARD
- 19 UNDER SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (5), FOR A FAMILY OF 8 OR MORE, THE
- 20 PAYMENT STANDARD IS INCREASED BY \$79.00 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL
- 21 FAMILY MEMBER OVER 7.
- 22 (7) THE DEPARTMENT MAY CONTRACT WITH A NONPROFIT
- 23 ORGANIZATION TO ASSIST RECIPIENTS WITH THE PROCESS FOR APPLYING
- 24 FOR SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
