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HOUSE BILL No. 6587

September 20, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Kolb, Kooiman, Stahl and Pastor and referred to the Committee on Family and Children Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 57n.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 57N. (1) A WORK FIRST PARTICIPANT MAY MEET THE WORK FIRST
- 2 PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT BY PARTICIPATING IN A COMPREHENSIVE BASIC
- 3 EDUCATION OR JOB SKILLS PROGRAM FOR A MINIMUM OF 30 HOURS PER WEEK.
- 4 PARTICIPATION IN A PROGRAM UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT EXCEED A
- 5 PERIOD LONGER THAN 180 DAYS.
- 6 (2) A WORK FIRST PARTICIPANT WHO HAS NOT EARNED A HIGH SCHOOL
- 7 DIPLOMA OR SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT
- 8 (GED) TEST SHALL ENROLL IN A GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT (GED)
- 9 PREPARATION COURSE AND MAY COUNT UP TO 10 HOURS EACH WEEK IN
 - ATTENDANCE AT THE GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT (GED) PREPARATION

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- 1 COURSE TOWARD HIS OR HER WORK FIRST PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT FOR A
- 2 PERIOD NOT LONGER THAN 180 DAYS.
- 3 (3) A WORK FIRST PARTICIPANT WHO HAS A READING PROFICIENCY AT
- 4 THE EIGHTH GRADE LEVEL OR LOWER SHALL PARTICIPATE IN A FAST TRACK
- 5 LITERACY PROGRAM FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 180 DAYS. PARTICIPATION
- 6 IN A FAST-TRACK LITERACY PROGRAM REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 7 SHALL COUNT TOWARD THE PARTICIPANT'S WORK FIRST WORK REQUIREMENT.
- 8 (4) UPON APPROVAL OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE WORK FIRST PROGRAM,
- 9 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ACCEPTED INTO A 2-YEAR POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION
- 10 PROGRAM OR WHO HAS COMPLETED 2 YEARS OF A 4-YEAR POSTSECONDARY
- 11 EDUCATION PROGRAM MAY ATTEND A COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR 4-YEAR
- 12 UNIVERSITY FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 24 MONTHS. AN INDIVIDUAL
- 13 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL MAINTAIN A 2.5 GRADE POINT AVERAGE OR
- 14 HIGHER AND SHALL MAINTAIN A 90% ATTENDANCE RECORD IN CLASSROOM
- 15 ACTIVITY. AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL WORK 20 HOURS
- 16 EACH WEEK WHILE ATTENDING A PROGRAM DESCRIBED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 17 TO MEET THE WORK FIRST PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT.
- 18 (5) EACH LOCAL WORK FIRST PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE A REPORT TO
- 19 THE LEGISLATURE THAT INCLUDES, AT A MINIMUM, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (A) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 21 ACHIEVING PERSONAL WORK PLAN GOALS.
- 22 (B) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 23 PLACED IN UNSUBSIDIZED EMPLOYMENT.
- 24 (C) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 25 PLACED IN EMPLOYMENT WHO REMAIN EMPLOYED FOR A PERIOD OF 180 DAYS
- 26 OR MORE.
- 27 (D) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS WHOSE

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- 1 CASES ARE CLOSED DUE TO SELF-SUFFICIENCY.
- 2 (E) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 3 ENROLLED IN A 2-YEAR OR 4-YEAR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM WITH INFORMATION
- 4 ON THE DEGREE PROGRAMS ENROLLED IN AND THE LOCAL WORK FIRST
- 5 PROGRAM'S PARTICIPANTS' GRADUATION RATE.
- 6 (F) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 7 PARTICIPATING IN A FAST TRACK LITERACY PROGRAM AND THE LOCAL WORK
- 8 FIRST PROGRAM'S PARTICIPANTS' SUCCESS RATE IN THIS PROGRAM.
- 9 (G) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 10 PARTICIPATING IN A HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION PROGRAM OR A GENERAL
- 11 EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT (GED) PROGRAM AND THE LOCAL WORK FIRST
- 12 PROGRAM'S PARTICIPANTS' GRADUATION RATE.
- 13 (6) FUNDING PROVIDED TO WORK FIRST PROGRAMS OR PROVIDERS
- 14 CONTRACTED TO ADMINISTER WORK FIRST PROGRAMS SHALL BE BASED ON THE
- 15 SUCCESS RATE IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS:
- 16 (A) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 17 ACHIEVING THE GOALS STATED IN THEIR PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT PLANS.
- 18 (B) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST PARTICIPANTS
- 19 PLACED IN EMPLOYMENT AND MAINTAINING EMPLOYMENT FOR A PERIOD OF 180
- 20 DAYS OR MORE.
- 21 (C) THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF WORK FIRST CASES CLOSED BY
- 22 EACH LOCAL MICHIGAN WORKS AGENCY DUE TO SELF-SUFFICIENCY.
