## **SENATE BILL No. 59**

January 25, 2005, Introduced by Senators CHERRY, JACOBS and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1846 RS 83, entitled "Of marriage and the solemnization thereof," by amending section 7 (MCL 551.7), as amended by 1983 PA 64.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Marriages may be solemnized by any of the 2 following:
  - (a) A judge of the district court, in the district in which the judge is serving.
  - (b) A district court magistrate, in the district in which the magistrate serves.
  - (c) A municipal judge, in the city in which the judge is serving or in a township over which a municipal court has jurisdiction -pursuant ACCORDING to section 9928 of -Act No. 236

- 4 (d) A judge of probate, in the county or probate court
- 5 district in which the judge is serving.
- 6 (e) A judge of a federal court.
- 7 (f) A mayor of a city, ANYWHERE in the city A COUNTY in
- 8 which -the mayor serves THAT CITY IS LOCATED.
- 9 (g) The county clerk of a county having more than 2,000,000
- 10 inhabitants or an employee of the clerk's office designated by the
- 11 county clerk, in the county in which the clerk serves.
- 12 (h) A minister of the gospel, anywhere in the state, if the
- 13 minister is ordained or authorized to solemnize marriages according
- 14 to the usages of the denomination, and is a pastor of a church in
- 15 this state, or continues to preach the gospel in this state.
- 16 (i) A minister of the gospel, anywhere in the state, if the
- 17 minister is not a resident of this state but is authorized to
- 18 solemnize marriages under the laws of the state in which the
- 19 minister resides.
- 20 (2) A person authorized by this act to solemnize a marriage
- 21 shall keep proper records and make returns as required by section 4
- 22 of Act No. 128 of the Public Acts of 1887, as amended, being
- 23 section 551.104 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1887 PA 128, MCL
- 24 551.104.
- 25 (3) If a mayor of a city solemnizes a marriage, the mayor
- 26 shall charge and collect a fee to be determined by the council of
- 27 that city, -which THAT shall be paid to the city treasurer and

- 1 deposited in the general fund of the city at the end of the month.
- 2 (4) If the county clerk of a county having more than 2,000,000
- 3 inhabitants or an employee of the clerk's office designated by the
- 4 county clerk solemnizes a marriage, the county clerk shall charge
- 5 and collect a fee to be determined by the commissioners of that
- 6 county, -which THAT shall be paid to the county treasurer and
- 7 deposited in the general fund of the county at the end of the
- 8 month.
