SENATE BILL No. 70

January 25, 2005, Introduced by Senators BIRKHOLZ, ALLEN and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding part 360.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 PART 360. ADOPT-A-WATERSHED PROGRAM
- 2 SEC. 36001. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 3 (A) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY
- 4 ACTING IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.
- 5 (B) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE ADOPT-A-WATERSHED PROGRAM PROVIDED FOR 6 IN SECTION 36003.
- 7 (C) "WATERSHED" MEANS THAT PART OF THE DRAINAGE AREA OF A BODY
- 8 OF WATER LOCATED WITHIN THIS STATE.
- 9 SEC. 36002. IT IS THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE TO DO BOTH OF
- 10 THE FOLLOWING:

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- 1 (A) ENCOURAGE A WATERSHED MANAGEMENT APPROACH IN MANAGING THE
- 2 WATER RESOURCES OF THE STATE. SINCE WATER FLOWING THROUGHOUT A
- 3 WATERSHED DRAINS INTO THE SAME BODY OF WATER, POLLUTION SOURCES
- 4 THROUGHOUT THE WATERSHED CAN AFFECT WATER QUALITY IN THAT BODY OF
- 5 WATER. A WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROVIDES A STABLE FOUNDATION FOR
- 6 CONFRONTING THE SOURCE OR SOURCES OF PERSISTENT WATER QUALITY
- 7 ISSUES.
- 8 (B) ENCOURAGE THE MEANINGFUL INVOLVEMENT OF THE PUBLIC IN
- 9 WATER RESOURCE PROTECTION AND RESTORATION EFFORTS. A WATERSHED
- 10 APPROACH ENCOURAGES REGIONAL AWARENESS OF AND SUPPORT FOR
- 11 PROTECTION OF WATER RESOURCES, WHILE STREAMLINING THE WORKLOAD AND
- 12 SAVING TIME AND MONEY FOR ENTITIES INVOLVED WITH THE PROTECTION OF
- 13 WATER RESOURCES.
- 14 SEC. 36003. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER A PROGRAM
- 15 ENTITLED THE ADOPT-A-WATERSHED PROGRAM.
- 16 (2) THE PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL ACTIVITIES,
- 17 BUT SHALL BE DIRECTED PRIMARILY TOWARD BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (A) ENCOURAGING AND FACILITATING THE INVOLVEMENT OF VOLUNTEER
- 19 GROUPS IN PROTECTING BODIES OF WATER THROUGH WATERSHED-BASED
- 20 CLEANUP, POLLUTION PREVENTION, AND CONSERVATION ACTIVITIES.
- 21 (B) ASSISTING VOLUNTEER GROUPS IN SELECTING A SPECIFIC
- 22 WATERSHED IN WHICH TO CONDUCT THE ACTIVITIES SPECIFIED IN
- 23 SUBDIVISION (A).
- 24 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM IN CONJUNCTION
- 25 WITH AND IN COOPERATION WITH OTHER STATE PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO
- 26 PROTECT WATER RESOURCES. IN DOING SO, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ENSURE
- 27 THAT THE SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM DOES NOT OVERLAP OR CONFLICT WITH

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- 1 OTHER SIMILAR WATER QUALITY PROGRAMS BEING ADMINISTERED BY THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT.
- 3 (4) THE DEPARTMENT MAY SEEK FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES
- 4 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND OTHER AVAILABLE FUNDING SOURCES
- 5 TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.
- 6 (5) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH A VOLUNTEER
- 7 GROUPS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM. AN AGREEMENT WITH A VOLUNTEER
- 8 GROUP SHALL IDENTIFY THE WATERSHED AND DESCRIBE THE
- 9 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE VOLUNTEER GROUP, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT
- 10 NEED NOT BE LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 11 (A) CLEANUP, POLLUTION PREVENTION, AND CONSERVATION ACTIVITIES
- 12 IN THE WATERSHED.
- 13 (B) PROGRAMS, SEMINARS, AND OTHER EDUCATIONAL AND PROMOTIONAL
- 14 ACTIVITIES.
- 15 (C) ENVIRONMENTAL TESTING AND MONITORING ACTIVITIES IN THE
- 16 WATERSHED.
- 17 (D) FUND-RAISING.
- 18 SEC. 36004. IN IMPLEMENTING THIS PART, THE DEPARTMENT MAY
- 19 PROVIDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING TO VOLUNTEER GROUPS:
- 20 (A) FUNDING.
- 21 (B) SUPPORT PERSONNEL.
- 22 (C) ENVIRONMENTAL TESTING AND MONITORING EQUIPMENT.
- 23 (D) SIGNS IDENTIFYING THE WATERSHED AND VOLUNTEER GROUP.
- 24 (E) TRAINING MATERIALS AND OTHER EDUCATIONAL AND PROMOTIONAL
- 25 MATERIAL.
- 26 SEC. 36005. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE VOLUNTEER GROUPS
- 27 CONDUCTING ACTIVITIES UNDER THIS PART WITH DATA INFORMATION SHEETS

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- 1 AND SHALL REQUEST THAT THE VOLUNTEER GROUPS RECORD ON THE DATA
- 2 INFORMATION SHEETS INFORMATION CONCERNING THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) THE SPECIFIC LOCATION OF THE WATERSHED.
- 4 (B) WILDLIFE IN THE WATERSHED.
- 5 (C) THEIR ENVIRONMENTAL TESTING AND MONITORING ACTIVITIES.
- 6 (D) THEIR CLEANUP, POLLUTION PREVENTION, AND CONSERVATION
- 7 ACTIVITIES.
- 8 (E) INFORMATION THAT MAY ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT IN
- 9 ADMINISTERING THE PROGRAM.
- 10 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COMPILE INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE
- 11 DATA INFORMATION SHEETS RECEIVED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) AND SHALL
- 12 INCLUDE THIS INFORMATION IN THE REPORT PREPARED UNDER SECTION
- 13 36006.
- 14 SEC. 36006. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ANNUALLY PREPARE A REPORT ON
- 15 THE IMPLEMENTATION AND PROGRESS OF THE PROGRAM. THE DEPARTMENT
- 16 SHALL PROVIDE THE GOVERNOR, SENATE, AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 17 WITH A COPY OF THE REPORT, POST THE REPORT ON WEBSITE, AND MAKE
- 18 COPIES OF THE REPORT AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC UPON REQUEST.
- 19 SEC. 36007. THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES TO IMPLEMENT
- 20 THIS PART.
