- 12 SEC. 16521. THE MICHIGAN BOARD OF ACUPUNCTURE IS CREATED IN
- 13 THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING 8 VOTING
- 14 MEMBERS WHO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF PART 161:
- 15 (A) FOUR ACUPUNCTURISTS. THE MEMBERS INITIALLY APPOINTED
- 16 UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION

- 23 CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD, MAY ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE
- 24 PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS ISSUED BY A CERTIFIED PROGRAM THAT IS

- 6 BENEFITS FOR SERVICES BY AN INDIVIDUAL REGISTERED AS AN
- 7 ACUPUNCTURIST UNDER THIS PART.
