A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1165a.

- 1 SEC. 1165A. (1) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 2006, THE DEPARTMENT
- 2 SHALL DEVELOP OR ADOPT, AND SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOLS, 1 OR
- 3 MORE MODEL PROGRAMS FOR ENTREPRENEURIAL EDUCATION. A PROGRAM UNDER
- 4 THIS SECTION SHALL BE DESIGNED TO INCORPORATE ENTREPRENEURIAL
- 5 EDUCATION THROUGHOUT THE CURRICULUM FOR GRADES K TO 12 AND SHALL BE
- 6 DESIGNED TO PROVIDE YOUNG PEOPLE WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO BEGIN
- 7 LEARNING ABOUT BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND TO BUILD A FOUNDATION FOR
- 8 ENTREPRENEURIAL EDUCATION BEFORE STARTING COLLEGE.
 - (2) EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IS ENCOURAGED TO ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT THE MODEL ENTREPRENEURIAL
