SENATE BILL No. 536

May 25, 2005, Introduced by Senators BISHOP, CASSIS, HARDIMAN, BIRKHOLZ, GARCIA and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 296, entitled

"An act to provide for the transfer of jurisdiction over highways; to provide for the final determination of disputes involving transfers of highway jurisdiction; and to supersede certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending sections 1 and 5 (MCL 247.851 and 247.855), section 5 as amended by 1980 PA 12, and by adding section 3a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- (a) "Highway authority" means the state highway commission, a
 board of county road commissioners, or the governing body of a city
 or village.
 - (b) "Highway" means a highway, road, or street.
 - (c) "Board" means the highway jurisdiction determination

- 1 (D) "COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION" MEANS THE BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD

- 11 OF A CITY OR VILLAGE WITHIN THAT COUNTY TRANSFER JURISDICTION OF A
- 12 ROAD THAT WAS ONCE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
- 13 ROAD COMMISSIONERS BACK TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS
- 14 IF THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MAKES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 15 FINDINGS:
- 16 (A) THE ROAD HAS BEEN BLOCKED OR CLOSED FOR MORE THAN 6 MONTHS
- 17 AND THE CITY OR VILLAGE CANNOT DEMONSTRATE A COMPELLING NEED FOR
- 18 BLOCKING OR CLOSING THE ROAD. THE FACT THAT A CITY OR VILLAGE HAS
- 19 JURISDICTION OVER THE ROAD AT THE TIME OF THE REQUEST OF THE COUNTY
- 20 BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DOES NOT DEMONSTRATE A COMPELLING NEED FOR
- 21 BLOCKING OR CLOSING THE ROAD.
- 22 (B) FOR PURPOSES OF HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE, THE ROAD
- 23 SHOULD NOT BE BLOCKED.
- 24 (C) THE ROAD IS USED TO SERVE MORE THAN 1 CITY OR VILLAGE
- 25 WITHIN THE COUNTY.
- 26 (2) THE REQUEST OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR A
- 27 TRANSFER OF JURISDICTION UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL BE MADE IN

- 1 WRITING AND ADDRESSED TO THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OR VILLAGE
- 2 THAT HAS JURISDICTION OVER THE ROAD.
- 3 (3) IF WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER A WRITTEN REQUEST IS RECEIVED BY A
- 4 GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OR VILLAGE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) THE
- 5 GOVERNING BODY OF A CITY OR VILLAGE DOES NOT CONSENT TO TRANSFER
- 6 JURISDICTION OF THE ROAD OR DOES NOT DEMONSTRATE A COMPELLING NEED
- 7 FOR BLOCKING THE ROAD, THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MAY
- 8 INITIATE PROCEEDINGS TO TRANSFER JURISDICTION OF THE ROAD BACK TO
- 9 THE COUNTY BOARD OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS UNDER THIS ACT.
- 10 Sec. 5. (1) The business -which THAT the board may perform
- 11 shall be conducted at a public meeting of the board held in
- 12 compliance with Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
- 13 amended, being sections 15.261 to 15.275 of the Michigan Compiled
- 14 Laws THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 TO 15.275.
- 15 Public notice of the time, date, and place of the meeting shall be
- 16 given in the manner required by Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of

- 16 Two members -shall constitute a quorum and the affirmative vote of
- 17 2 members is necessary for a final determination of the dispute. If
- 18 a member of the board becomes unable to perform the member's duties
- 19 as a board member, a new member shall be selected as prescribed in
